- Then Ishmael took captive all the remnant of the people who were in Mizpah, the **daughters** of the **king** and all the people who were remaining over in Mizpah, whom **Nebuzaradan** the **chief** of the **bodyguard** had put in the custody of **Gedaliah** the **son** of **Ahikam**. So Ishmael the **son** of Nethaniah took them captive and went off to cross over to the **sons** of Ammon. (**Jeremiah 41:10**)
- And some of the people, the lowly ones who had nothing at all, **Nebuzaradan** the **chief** of the **bodyguard** **let** remain in the land of Judah, and he went on to give them vineyards and compulsory services on that day. (**Jeremiah 39:10**)
- In time all the **chiefs** of the military forces who were in the field, they and their **men**, got to hear that the **king** of Babylon had commissioned **Gedaliah** the **son** of **Ahikam** over the land and that he had commissioned him over the **men** and women and **little children** and some of the lowly people of the land, who had not been taken into exile in Babylon. (**Jeremiah 40:7**)
- As for the people left behind in the land of Judah, whom Nebuchadnezzar the **king** of Babylon had left behind, he now appointed over them **Gedaliah** the **son** of **Ahikam** the **son** of **Shaphan**. (**2 Kings 25:22**)
- Then the **king** commanded Hilkiyah and **Ahikam** the **son** of **Shaphan** and Abdon the **son** of Micah and **Shaphan** the secretary and Asaiah the king's servant, saying; (**2 Chronicles 34:20**)
- Moreover, it was the hand of **Ahikam** the **son** of **Shaphan** that proved to be with **Jeremiah**, in order not to give him into the hand of the people to have him put to death. (**Jeremiah 26:24**)
- Later Hilkiyah the High Priest said to **Shaphan** the secretary; The very book of the Law I have found in the house of Yehowah. So

Hilkiah gave the book to **Shaphan**, and he began to read it. (**2 Kings 22:8**)

- Further, the **king** commanded Jerahmeel the **son** of the **king** and Seraiah the **son** of Azriel and Shelemiah the **son** of Abdeel to get **Baruch** the secretary and **Jeremiah** the **prophet**. But Yehowah kept them concealed. (**Jeremiah 36:26**)
- The word that **Jeremiah** the **prophet** spoke to **Baruch** the **son** of **Neria** when he wrote in a book these words from the mouth of **Jeremiah** in the fourth year of Jehoiakim the **son** of Josiah, the **king** of Judah, saying; (**Jeremiah 45:1**)
- And, look! All the women that have been left remaining in the house of the **king** of Judah are being brought out to the princes of the **king** of Babylon, and they are saying; The **men** at peace with you have allured you and prevailed over you. They have caused your foot to sink down into the very ooze, they have retreated in the opposite direction. (**Jeremiah 38:22**)
- But as for you, you keep seeking great things for yourself. Do not keep on seeking. For here I am bringing in a calamity upon all flesh, is the utterance of Yehowah, and I will give you your **soul** as a spoil in all the places to which you may go. (**Jeremiah 45:5**)
