Jeremiah 43:7" And they finally came into the land of Egypt, for they did not obey the voice of Yehowah, and they came gradually as far as Tahpanhes.

- In that day there will prove to be five cities in the land of Egypt speaking the language of Canaan and swearing to Yehowah of armies. The City of Tearing Down will one city be called. (Isaiah 19:18)
- For his princes have come to be in Zoan itself, and his own envoys reach even Hanes. (Isaiah 30:4)
- Even the sons of Noph and Tahpanes themselves kept feeding on you at the crown of the head. (Jeremiah 2:16)
- The word that occurred to Jeremiah for all the Jews that were dwelling in the land of Egypt, the ones dwelling in Migdol and in Tahpanhes and in Noph and in the land of Pathros, saying; (Jeremiah 44:1)
- And in Tehaphnehes the day will actually grow dark, when I break there the yoke bars of Egypt. And in her the pride of her strength will actually be made to cease. As for her, clouds themselves will cover her, and into captivity her own dependent towns will go. (Ezekiel 30:18)
- After that all the people, from small to great, and the chiefs of the military forces rose up and came into Egypt, for they had become afraid because of the Chaldeans. (2 Kings 25:26)
- Will not those devising mischief go wandering about? But there are loving-kindness and trueness as regards those devising good.
 (Proverbs 14:22)
- In that day there will prove to be an altar to Yehowah in the midst of the land of Egypt, and a pillar to Yehowah beside its boundary. (Isaiah 19:19)
- And it must occur in that day that there will be a blowing on a great horn, and those who are perishing in the land of Assyria and those who are dispersed in the land of Egypt will certainly come and bow down to Yehowah in the holy mountain in Jerusalem. (Isaiah 27:13)

- And I will make justice the measuring line and righteousness the leveling instrument, and the hail must sweep away the refuge of a lie, and the waters themselves will flood out the very place of concealment. (Isaiah 28:17)
- And like the bad figs that cannot be eaten for badness, this in fact is what Yehowah has said; So I shall give Zedekiah the king of Judah and his princes and the remnant of Jerusalem who are remaining over in this land and those who are dwelling in the land of Egypt. (Jeremiah 24:8)
- So they went and took up dwelling in the lodging place of Chimham that was beside Bethlehem, in order to go on and enter into Egypt. (Jeremiah 41:17)
- Saying; No, but into the land of Egypt we shall enter, where we shall see no war and the sound of the horn we shall not hear and for bread we shall not go hungry, and there is where we shall dwell. (Jeremiah 42:14)
- And all the men who were knowing that their wives had been making sacrificial smoke to other gods, and all the wives who were standing as a great congregation, and all the people who were dwelling in the land of Egypt, in Pathros, proceeded to answer Jeremiah, saying; (Jeremiah 44:15)
- And Jeremiah continued on to say to all the people and to all the women; Hear the word of Yehowah, all Judah who are in the land of Egypt. (Jeremiah 44:24)
- Therefore hear the word of Yehowah, all Judah who are dwelling in the land of Egypt, Here I myself have sworn by my great name, Yehowah has said, that my name will no more prove to be something called out by the mouth of any man of Judah, saying; As the Sovereign Lord Yehowah is alive! In all the land of Egypt. (Jeremiah 44:26)
- Tell it in Egypt, O men, and publish it in Migdol, and publish it in Noph and in Tahpanhes. Say, Station yourself, making preparation also for yourself, for a sword will certainly devour all around you. (Jeremiah 46:14)
