

**Jeremiah 44:10** And down to this day they did not feel crushed, and they did not become afraid, nor did they walk in my Law and in my statutes that I put before you and before your forefathers.

[7] - References:

- The sacrifices to God are a broken spirit, a heart broken and **crushed**, O God, you will not despise. (**Psalms 51:17**)
- Happy is the man that is feeling dread constantly, but he that is hardening his heart will fall into calamity. (**Proverbs 28:14**)
- And they felt no dread, neither did the king and all his servants, who were listening to all these words, rip their garments apart. (**Jeremiah 36:24**)
- However, they became disobedient and rebelled against you and kept casting your Law behind their back, and your own prophets they killed, who bore witness against them to bring them back to you, and they went on committing acts of great disrespect. (**Nehemiah 9:26**)
- In order that you may fear Yehowah your God so as to keep all his **statutes** and his commandments that I am commanding you, you and your son and your grandson, all the **days** of your life, and in order that your **days** may prove long. (**Deuteronomy 6:2**)
- But they, the house of Israel, rebelled against me in the wilderness. In my **statutes** they did not **walk**, and my judicial decisions they rejected, which, should the man keep doing, he will also keep living by them. And my Sabbaths they profaned very much, so that I promised to pour out my fury upon them in the wilderness, in order to exterminate them. (**Ezekiel 20:13**)
- And you must say to them; This is what Yehowah has said; If **you** will not listen to me by walking in my Law that I have **put before you**. (**Jeremiah 26:4**)
