Jeremiah 44:16. As regards the word that you have spoken to us in the name of Yehowah, we are not listening to you.

[9] - References:

- A wicked man has put on a bold face, but the upright is the one that will firmly establish his ways. (Proverbs 21:29)
- The very expression of their faces actually testifies against them, and of their sin like that of Sodom they do tell. They have not hidden it. Woe to their soul! For they have dealt out to themselves calamity. (Isaiah 3:9)
- This is what Yehowah has said; Stand still in the ways, YOU people, and see, and ask for the roadways of long ago, where, now, the good way is, and walk in it, and find ease for YOUR souls. But they kept saying; We are not going to walk. (Jeremiah 6:16)
- But they did not listen, nor did they incline their ear to turn back from their badness by not making sacrificial smoke to other gods. (Jeremiah 44:5)
- Those to whom he has said; This is the resting-place. GIVE rest to the weary one. And this is the place of ease, but who were not willing to hear. (Isaiah 28:12)
- For this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah, the Holy One of Israel, has said; By coming back and resting you people will be saved. Your mightiness will prove to be simply in keeping undisturbed and in trustfulness. But you were not willing. (Isaiah 30:15)
- Due to my knowing that you are hard and that your neck is an iron sinew and your forehead is copper. (Isaiah 48:4)
- But if you are saying; No, we are not going to dwell in this land! In order to disobey the voice of Yehowah YOUR God. (Jeremiah 42:13)
- Do not become like YOUR fathers to whom the former prophets called, saying; This is what Yehowah of armies has said, Return, please, from YOUR bad ways and from YOUR bad dealings. But they did not listen, and they paid no attention to me, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Zechariah 1:4)
