

Jeremiah 44:16 As regards the word that you have spoken to us in the name of Yehowah, we are not listening to you.

[9] - References:

- A wicked man has put on a bold face, but the upright is the one that will firmly establish his ways. (**Proverbs 21:29**)
- The very expression of their faces actually testifies against them, and of their sin like that of Sodom they do tell. They **have** not hidden it. Woe to their soul! For they **have** dealt out to themselves calamity. (**Isaiah 3:9**)
- This is what **Yehowah** has said; Stand still in the ways, **YOU** people, and see, and ask for the roadways of long ago, where, now, the good way is, and walk in it, and find ease for **YOUR** souls. But they kept saying; We are not going to walk. (**Jeremiah 6:16**)
- But they did not listen, nor did they incline their ear to turn back from their badness by not making sacrificial smoke to other gods. (**Jeremiah 44:5**)
- Those to whom he has said; This is the resting-place. **GIVE** rest to the weary one. And this is the place of ease, but who were not willing to hear. (**Isaiah 28:12**)
- For this is what the Sovereign Lord **Yehowah**, the Holy One of Israel, has said; By coming back and resting **YOU** people will be saved. **YOUR** mightiness will prove to be simply in keeping undisturbed and in trustfulness. But **YOU** were not willing. (**Isaiah 30:15**)
- Due to my knowing that you are hard and that your neck is an iron sinew and your forehead is copper. (**Isaiah 48:4**)
- But if **YOU** are saying; No, we are not going to dwell in this land! In order to disobey the voice of **Yehowah YOUR** God. (**Jeremiah 42:13**)
- Do not become like **YOUR** fathers to whom the former prophets called, saying; This is what **Yehowah** of armies has said, Return, please, from **YOUR** bad ways and from **YOUR** bad dealings. But they did not listen, and they paid no attention to me, is the utterance of **Yehowah**. (**Zechariah 1:4**)
