Jeremiah 44:17. But we shall positively do every word that has gone forth from our mouth, in order to make sacrificial smoke to the queen of the heavens and to pour out to her drink offerings, just as we ourselves and our forefathers, our kings and our princes did in the cities of Judah and in the streets of Jerusalem, when we used to be satisfied with bread and to be well off, and we did not see any calamity at all.

- But if her husband has totally annulled them on the day of his hearing any expression of her lips as her vows or as an abstinence vow of her soul, they will not stand. Her husband has annulled them, and Yehowah will forgive her. (Numbers 30:12)
- They have enclosed themselves with their own fat, with their mouth they have spoken in haughtiness. (Psalms 17:10)
- So they will eat from the fruitage of their way, and they will be glutted with their own counsels. (Proverbs 1:31)
- And that you may not raise your eyes to the heavens and indeed see the sun and the moon and the stars, all the army of the heavens, and actually get seduced and bow down to them and serve them, which Yehowah your God has apportioned to all the peoples under the whole heavens. (Deuteronomy 4:19)
- And he should go and worship other gods and bow down to them or to the sun or the moon or all the army of the heavens, a thing that I have not commanded. (Deuteronomy 17:3)
- Also, when we were making sacrificial smoke to the queen of the heavens and were disposed to pour out drink offerings to her, did we without asking our husbands make for her sacrificial cakes, in order to make an image of her, and to pour out drink offerings to her? (Jeremiah 44:19)
- For they are a nation on whom counsel perishes, and among them there is no understanding. (Deuteronomy 32:28)

- The sons are picking up sticks of wood, and the fathers are lighting the fire, and the wives are kneading flour dough in order to make sacrificial cakes to the queen of the heavens, and there is a pouring out of drink offerings to other gods for the purpose of offending me. (Jeremiah 7:18)
- And the Chaldeans who are fighting against this city must come in and set this city aflame with fire and must burn it down and the houses upon the roofs of which they have made sacrificial smoke to Baal and have poured out drink offerings to other gods for the purpose of offending me. (Jeremiah 32:29)
- And they kept leaving all the commandments of Yehowah their God and proceeded to make for themselves molten statues, two calves, and to make a sacred pole, and they began to bow down to all the army of the heavens and to serve Baal. (2 Kings 17:16)
- As for our kings, our princes, our priests and our forefathers, they have not performed your Law, nor paid attention to your commandments or to your testimonies with which you bore witness against them. (Nehemiah 9:34)
- We have sinned just the same as our forefathers, we have done wrong, we have acted wickedly. (Psalms 106:6)
- Nevertheless, Yehowah did not turn back from the great burning of his anger, with which his anger burned against Judah over all the offensive things with which Manasseh had made them offend. (2 Kings 23:26)
- And he continued to do what was bad in the eyes of Yehowah his God. He did not humble himself on account of Jeremiah the prophet at the order of Yehowah. (2 Chronicles 36:12)
- O Yehowah, to us belongs the shame of face, to our kings, to our princes and to our forefathers, because we have sinned against you. (Daniel 9:8)
- And the sons of Israel kept saying to them; If only we had died by Yehowah's hand in the land of Egypt while we were sitting by the pots of meat, while we were eating bread to satisfaction, because you have brought us out into this wilderness to put this whole congregation to death by famine. (Exodus 16:3)
- And there on all the high places they continued to make sacrificial smoke the same as the nations whom Yehowah had

- taken into exile because of them, and they kept doing bad things to offend Yehowah. (2 Kings 17:11)
- The inexperienced ones will certainly take possession of foolishness, but the shrewd ones will bear knowledge as a headdress. (Proverbs 14:18)
- Because sentence against a bad work has not been executed speedily, that is why the heart of the sons of men has become fully set in them to do bad. (Ecclesiastes 8:11)
- I also kept telling you from that time. Before it could come in, I caused you to hear it, that you might not say, My own idol has done them, and my own carved image and my own molten image have commanded them. (Isaiah 48:5)
- With the smooth stones of the torrent valley was your portion. They, they were your lot. Moreover, to them you poured out a drink offering, you offered up a gift. For these things shall I comfort myself? (Isaiah 57:6)
- In the multitude of your ways you have toiled. You have not said, It is hopeless! You have found a revival of your own power. That is why you have not grown sick. (Isaiah 57:10)
- Hold your foot back from becoming barefoot, and your throat from thirst. But you proceeded to say; It is hopeless! No, but I have fallen in love with strangers, and after them I am going to walk. (Jeremiah 2:25)
- But they kept on walking after the stubbornness of their heart and after the Baal images, about which their fathers had taught them. (Jeremiah 9:14)
- And the houses of Jerusalem and the houses of the kings of Judah must become like the place of Topheth, unclean ones, that is, all the houses upon the roofs of which they made sacrificial smoke to all the army of the heavens and there was a pouring out of drink offerings to other gods. (Jeremiah 19:13)
- As for the sacrificial smoke that You made in the cities of Judah and in the streets of Jerusalem, You and Your forefathers, Your kings and Your princes and the people of the land, was it not this that Yehowah remembered and that proceeded to come up into his heart? (Jeremiah 44:21)

- This is what Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, has said; As for you men and your wives, you women also speak with your mouths, and with your hands you people have made a fulfillment, saying; We shall without fail perform our vows that we have vowed, to make sacrificial smoke to the queen of the heavens and to pour out drink offerings to her. You women will without fail carry out your vows, and you will without fail perform your vows. (Jeremiah 44:25)
- Yehowah, and, look! At the entrance of the temple of Yehowah, between the porch and the altar, there were about twenty-five men with their backs to the temple of Yehowah and their faces to the east, and they were bowing down to the east, to the sun. (Ezekiel 8:16)
- And that which is coming up into YOUR spirit will itself positively not happen, in that YOU are saying; Let us become like the nations, like the families of the lands, in ministering to wood and stone. (Ezekiel 20:32)
- And you sat down upon a glorious couch, with a table set in order before it, and my incense and my oil you put upon it. (Ezekiel 23:41)
- And they will come in to you, like the coming in of people, and sit before you as my people, and they will certainly hear your words but these they will not do, for with their mouth they are expressing lustful desires and after their unjust gain is where their heart is going. (Ezekiel 33:31)
- But she herself did not recognize that it was I who had given to her the grain and the sweet wine and the oil, and that I had made silver itself abound for her, and gold, which they made use of for Baal. (Hosea 2:8)
