Jeremiah 44:2" This is what Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, has said; You yourselves have seen all the calamity that I have brought in upon Jerusalem and upon all the cities of Judah, and here they are a devastated place this day, and in them there is no inhabitant.

- And the walls of Jerusalem, all around, the entire military force of Chaldeans that were with the chief of the bodyguard pulled down. (2 Kings 25:10)
- So he brought up against them the king of the Chaldeans, who proceeded to kill their young men with the sword in the house of their sanctuary, neither did he feel compassion for young man or virgin, old or decrepit. Everything He gave into his hand. (2 Chronicles 36:17)
- And the house of the king and the houses of the people the Chaldeans burned with fire, and the walls of Jerusalem they pulled down. (Jeremiah 39:8)
- And all the walls of Jerusalem, round about, all the military forces of the Chaldeans that were with the chief of the bodyguard pulled down. (Jeremiah 52:14)
- And I will make Jerusalem piles of stones, the lair of jackals, and the cities of Judah I shall make a desolate waste, without an inhabitant. (Jeremiah 9:11)
- O how she has come to sit solitary, the city that was abundant with people! How she has become like a widow, she that was populous among the nations! How she that was a princess among the jurisdictional districts has come to be for forced labor! (Lamentations 1:1)
- Here I am commanding, is the utterance of Yehowah, and I shall certainly bring them back to this city, and they must fight against it and capture it and burn it with fire, and the cities of Judah I shall make a desolate waste without an inhabitant. (Jeremiah 34:22)
- And I shall actually make the land a desolate waste, even a desolation, and the pride of its strength must be made to cease

- and the mountains of Israel must be laid desolate, with no one passing through. (Ezekiel 33:28)
- And Yehowah kept alert to the calamity and finally brought it upon us, for Yehowah our God is righteous in all his works that he has done, and we have not obeyed his voice. (Daniel 9:14)
