

Jeremiah 44:22· Finally Yehowah was no longer able to put up with it because of the badness of **YOUR** dealings, because of the detestable things that **YOU** had done, and so **YOUR** land came to be a devastated place and an object of astonishment and a malediction, without an inhabitant, as at this day.

[13] - References:

- Now the end is upon you, and I must send my anger against you, and I will judge you according to your ways and bring upon you all your **detestable things**. (**Ezekiel 7:3**)
- And this house itself will become heaps of ruins. Everyone passing by it will stare in amazement and will certainly whistle and say, For what reason did **Yehowah** do like that to this **land** and this house? (**1 Kings 9:8**)
- Fruitful **land** into salt country, owing to the **badness** of those dwelling in it. (**Psalms 107:34**)
- And all this **land** must become a **devastated place**, an **object of astonishment**, and these nations will have to serve the king of Babylon seventy years. (**Jeremiah 25:11**)
- At you all those passing along on the road have clapped their hands. They have whistled and kept wagging their head at the daughter of Jerusalem, saying; Is this the city of which they used to say, It is the perfection of prettiness, an exultation for all the earth? (**Lamentations 2:15**)
- But as for those whose heart is walking in their disgusting **things** and their **detestable things**, upon their head I shall certainly bring their own way, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 11:21**)
- And they will have to know that I am **Yehowah** when I make the **land** a desolate waste, even a desolation, on account of all their **detestable things** that they have done. (**Ezekiel 33:29**)
- I have kept quiet for a long time. I continued silent. I kept exercising self-control. Like a woman giving birth I am going to groan, pant, and gasp at the same time. (**Isaiah 42:14**)

- Should I not take an accounting because of these very things? Is the utterance of **Yehowah**. Or upon a nation that is like this should not my soul avenge itself? (**Jeremiah 5:9**)
- Namely, Jerusalem and the cities of Judah and her kings, her princes, to make them a **devastated place**, an **object of astonishment**, something to whistle at and a **malediction**, just as at this **day**. (**Jeremiah 25:18**)
- And I will leave remaining from them a few men from the sword, from the famine and from the pestilence, in order that they may recount all their **detestable things** among the nations to whom they must come in, and they will have to know that I am **Yehowah**. (**Ezekiel 12:16**)
- Therefore say to them; This is what the Sovereign Lord **Yehowah** has said; With the blood **you** keep eating, and **YOUR** eyes **YOU** keep lifting to **YOUR** dungy idols, and blood **you** keep pouring out. So should **you** possess the **land**? (**Ezekiel 33:25**)
- This is what you should say to them; This is what the Sovereign Lord **Yehowah** has said; As I am alive, surely the ones who are in the **devastated places** will fall by the sword itself, and the one who is upon the surface of the field, to the wild beast I shall certainly give him for food, and those who are in the strong **places** and in the caves will die by the pestilence itself. (**Ezekiel 33:27**)
