Jeremiah 44:26... Therefore hear the word of Yehowah, all Judah who are dwelling in the land of Egypt, Here I myself have sworn by my great name; Yehowah has said, that my name will no more prove to be something called out by the mouth of any man¹ of Judah, saying, As the Sovereign Lord Yehowah is alive! In all the land of Egypt.
