

Jeremiah 44:27 **Here I am keeping alert toward them for calamity and not for good, and all the men of Judah that are in the land of Egypt will certainly come to their finish by the sword and by the famine, until they cease to be.**

- See, I have commissioned you this day to be over the nations and over the kingdoms, in order to uproot and to pull down and to destroy and to tear down, to build and to plant. (**Jeremiah 1:10**)
- Your way and your dealings, there **will** be a rendering of these to you. This is the **calamity** upon you, for it is bitter, because it has reached clear to your heart. (**Jeremiah 4:18**)
- And it must occur that **you will** say; Due to what fact has Yehowah our God done to us all these things? And you must say to them; Just as **you** have left me and have gone serving a foreign god in **your land**, so **you will** serve strangers in a **land** that is not **yours**. (**Jeremiah 5:19**)
- And Yehowah of armies himself, the Planter of you, has spoken against you a **calamity** on account of the badness of the house of Israel and the house of **Judah** that they have committed on their own part to offend me in making sacrificial smoke to Baal. (**Jeremiah 11:17**)
- For I have set my face against this city for **calamity** and not for good, is the utterance of Yehowah. Into the hand of the king of Babylon it **will** be given, and he **will certainly** burn it with fire. (**Jeremiah 21:10**)
- And it must occur that just as I had kept **alert toward** them to uproot and to pull down and to tear down and to destroy and to do damage, so I shall keep **alert toward** them to build up and to plant, is the utterance of Yehowah. (**Jeremiah 31:28**)
- An end itself must **come**. The end must **come**, it must awaken for you. Look! It is coming. (**Ezekiel 7:6**)
- And I **will** take the remnant of **Judah** who set their faces to enter into the **land** of **Egypt** to reside there as aliens, and they **will** all **certainly come** to their **finish** in the **land** of **Egypt**. They **will** fall by the **sword**, and by the **famine** they **will come** to their **finish**, from the smallest one even to the greatest one, by the **sword** and

by the **famine** they **will** die. And they must become a curse, an object of astonishment and a malediction and a reproach. **(Jeremiah 44:12)**

- And you **will** have to serve your enemies whom Yehowah **will** send against you with hunger and thirst and nakedness and the want of everything, and he **will certainly** put an iron yoke upon your neck **until** he has annihilated you. **(Deuteronomy 28:48)**
- The woman giving birth to seven has faded away, her soul has struggled for breath. Her sun has set while it is yet day, it has become ashamed and felt abashed. And to the **sword** I shall give the mere remnant of them before their enemies, is the utterance of Yehowah. **(Jeremiah 15:9)**
- It must also occur that the very **sword** of which **you** are afraid **will** there catch up with **you** in the **land** of **Egypt**, and the very **famine** at which **you** are in a fright **will** there closely follow after **you** to **Egypt**, and there is where **you will** die. **(Jeremiah 42:16)**
- Ethiopia and Put and Lud and all the mixed company and Chub and the sons of the **land** of the covenant, with them they **will** fall by the very **sword**. **(Ezekiel 30:5)**
