

Jeremiah 44:4 **And I kept sending to you all my servants the prophets, rising up early and sending, saying; Do not do, please, this detestable sort of thing that I have hated.**

[10] - References:

- And Yehowah the God of their forefathers kept **sending** against them by means of his messengers, **sending** again and again, because he felt compassion for his people and for his dwelling. (**2 Chronicles 36:15**)
- I **have** spread out my hands all day long to a stubborn people, those who are walking in the way that is not good, after their thoughts. (**Isaiah 65:2**)
- From the day that **YOUR** forefathers came forth out of the land of Egypt until this day, and I kept **sending** to **you** all my **servants** the **prophets**, daily getting up **early** and **sending** them. (**Jeremiah 7:25**)
- And Yehowah sent to **you** all his **servants** the **prophets**, **rising** up **early** and **sending** them, but **you** did not listen, neither did **you** incline **YOUR** ear to listen. (**Jeremiah 25:4**)
- By listening to the words of my **servants** the **prophets**, whom I am **sending** to **you**, even **rising** up **early** and **sending** them, whom **you have** not listened to. (**Jeremiah 26:5**)
- Due to the fact that they **have** not listened to my words, is the utterance of Yehowah, that I **have** sent to them with my **servants** the **prophets**, getting up **early** and **sending** them. But **you have** not listened, is the utterance of Yehowah. (**Jeremiah 29:19**)
- And I kept **sending** to **you** all my **servants** the **prophets**, **rising** up **early** and **sending** them, **saying**, Turn back, **please**, each one from his bad way, and make **YOUR** dealings good, and do not walk after other gods to serve them. And keep dwelling on the ground that I **have** given to **you** and to **YOUR** forefathers. But **you** did not incline **YOUR** ear, nor did **you** listen to me. (**Jeremiah 35:15**)
- And, first of all, I will repay the full amount of their error and of their sin, on account of their profaning my land. With the corpses of their disgusting things and their **detestable** things they had filled my inheritance. (**Jeremiah 16:18**)

- **Neither should you set up for yourself a sacred pillar, a thing Yehowah your God hates indeed. (Deuteronomy 16:22)**
- **Should *you* not obey the words that Yehowah called out by means of the former *prophets*, while Jerusalem happened to be inhabited, and at ease, with her cities all around her, and while the Negeb and the Shephelah were inhabited? (Zechariah 7:7)**
