Jeremiah 44:4... And I kept sending to you all my servants the prophets, rising up early and sending, saying; Do not do, please, this detestable sort of thing that I have hated.

[10] - References:

- And Yehowah the God of their forefathers kept sending against them by means of his messengers, sending again and again, because he felt compassion for his people and for his dwelling. (2 Chronicles 36:15)
- I have spread out my hands all day long to a stubborn people, those who are walking in the way that is not good, after their thoughts. (Isaiah 65:2)
- From the day that YOUR forefathers came forth out of the land of Egypt until this day, and I kept sending to YOU all my servants the prophets, daily getting up early and sending them. (Jeremiah 7:25)
- And Yehowah sent to you all his servants the prophets, rising up early and sending them, but you did not listen, neither did you incline your ear to listen. (Jeremiah 25:4)
- By listening to the words of my servants the prophets, whom I am sending to You, even rising up early and sending them, whom You have not listened to. (Jeremiah 26:5)
- Due to the fact that they have not listened to my words, is the utterance of Yehowah, that I have sent to them with my servants the prophets, getting up early and sending them. But you have not listened, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 29:19)
- And I kept sending to you all my servants the prophets, rising up early and sending them, saying, Turn back, please, each one from his bad way, and make your dealings good, and do not walk after other gods to serve them. And keep dwelling on the ground that I have given to you and to your forefathers. But you did not incline your ear, nor did you listen to me. (Jeremiah 35:15)
- And, first of all, I will repay the full amount of their error and of their sin, on account of their profaning my land. With the corpses of their disgusting things and their detestable things they had filled my inheritance. (Jeremiah 16:18)

- Neither should you set up for yourself a sacred pillar, a thing Yehowah your God hates indeed. (Deuteronomy 16:22)
- Should you not obey the words that Yehowah called out by means of the former prophets, while Jerusalem happened to be inhabited, and at ease, with her cities all around her, and while the Negeb and the Shephelah were inhabited? (Zechariah 7:7)
