[16] - References:

- Be minded the same way toward others as to yourselves, do not be minding lofty **things**, but be led along with the lowly **things**. Do not become discreet in **YOUR** own eyes. (**Romans 12:16**)
- And those making use of the world as those not using it to the full, for the scene of this world is changing. (**1 Corinthians 7:31**)
- To be sure, it is a means of **great** gain, this godly devotion along with self-sufficiency. (**1 Timothy 6:6**)
- Let **YOUR** manner of life be free of the love of money, while **YOU** are content with the present **things**. For he has said; I **will** by no means leave you nor by any means forsake you. (**Hebrews 13:5**)
- That **YOU** may make sure of the more important **things**, so that **YOU** may be flawless and not be stumbling others up to the day of Christ. (**Philippians 1:10**)
- For as fire **Yehowah** himself **will** for a fact take up the controversy, yes, with his sword, against all flesh, and the slain of **Yehowah will** certainly become many. (**Isaiah 66:16**)
- And all the kings of the north who are near and far away, one after the other, and all the other kingdoms of the earth that are on the surface of the ground, and the king of Sheshach himself **will** drink after them. (**Jeremiah 25:26**)
- Therefore **keep** yourselves in expectation of me, is the **utterance** of **Yehowah**, till the day of my rising up to the booty, for my judicial decision is to gather nations, for me to collect together kingdoms, in order to pour out upon them my denunciation, all my burning anger, for by the fire of my zeal all the earth **will** be devoured. (**Zephaniah 3:8**)
- The one sitting still in this city **will** die by the sword and by the famine and by the pestilence, but the one who is going out and who actually falls away to the Chaldeans who are laying siege

- against **you will keep** living, and his **soul will** certainly come to be his as a **spoil**. (**Jeremiah 21:9**)
- For I shall without fail furnish you an escape, and by the sword you **will** not fall, and you **will** certainly come to have your **soul** as a **spoil**, because you have trusted in me, is the **utterance** of Yehowah. (**Jeremiah 39:18**)
 - Even the able-bodied men and the wives and the little children and the daughters of the king and every **soul** that Nebuzaradan the chief of the bodyguard had let stay with Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan, and Jeremiah the prophet and Baruch the son of Neriah. (**Jeremiah 43:6**)
 - And it came about that, as soon as they had brought them forth to the outskirts, he began to say; Escape for your **soul**! Do not look behind you and do not stand still in all the District! Escape to the mountainous region for fear you may be swept away! (**Genesis 19:17**)
 - **Yehowah** himself **will** guard him and preserve him alive. He **will** be pronounced happy in the earth, and you cannot possibly **give** him over to the **soul** of his enemies. (**Psalms 41:2**)
 - O **Yehowah**, my heart has not been haughty, nor have my eyes been lofty, nor have I walked in **things** too **great**, nor in **things** too wonderful for me. (**Psalms 131:1**)
 - This is what **Yehowah** has said; The one continuing to dwell in this city is the one that **will** die by the sword, by the famine and by the pestilence. But the one going out to the Chaldeans is the one that **will keep** living and that **will** certainly come to have his **soul** as a **spoil** and alive. (**Jeremiah 38:2**)
 - But as for you, in case you have warned someone wicked and he does not actually turn back from his wickedness and from his wicked way, he himself for his error **will** die, but as for you, you **will** have delivered your own **soul**. (**Ezekiel 3:19**)
