- The word that occurred to Jeremiah for all the Jews that were dwelling in the land of **Egypt**, the ones dwelling in **Migdol** and in **Tahpanhes** and in **Noph** and in the land of Pathros, saying; (**Jeremiah 44:1**)
- Therefore here I am against you and against your Nile canals, and I **will** make the land of **Egypt** devastated places, dryness, a desolated waste, from **Migdol** to Syene and to the boundary of Ethiopia. (**Ezekiel 29:10**)
- This is what Yehowah has said; The supporters of **Egypt** must also fall, and the pride of its strength must come down. From **Migdol** to Syene they **will** fall in it even by the sword, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 30:6**)
- The princes of Zoan have acted foolishly, the princes of **Noph** have been deceived, the keymen of her tribes have caused **Egypt** to wander about. (**Isaiah 19:13**)
- Even the sons of **Noph** and Tahpanes themselves kept feeding on you at the crown of the head. (**Jeremiah 2:16**)
- For, look! They **will** have to go because of despoiling. **Egypt** itself **will** collect them together, Memphis, for its part, **will** bury them. As for their desirable things of silver, nettles themselves **will** take possession of them, thorny bushes **will** be in their tents. (**Hosea 9:6**)
- And they finally came into the land of **Egypt**, for they did not obey the voice of Yehowah, and they came gradually as far as **Tahpanhes**. (**Jeremiah 43:7**)
- And in Tehaphnehes the day **will** actually grow dark, when I break there the yoke bars of **Egypt**. And in her the pride of her strength **will** actually be made to cease. As for her, clouds

- themselves **will** cover her, and into captivity her own dependent towns **will** go. (**Ezekiel 30:18**)
- Against her they have sanctified war; Rise up, and let us go up at midday! Woe to us, for the day has declined, for the shadows of evening keep extending themselves! (**Jeremiah 6:4**)
  - Proclaim this, **you** people, among the nations; Sanctify war! Arouse the powerful **men**! Let them draw near! Let them come up, all the **men** of war! (**Joel 3:9**)
  - Yehowah has a **sword**, it must be filled with blood, it must be made greasy with the fat, with the blood of young rams and he-goats, with the fat of the kidneys of rams. For Yehowah has a sacrifice in Bozrah, and a great slaughtering in the land of Edom. (**Isaiah 34:6**)
  - To no effect I have struck **YOUR** sons. No discipline did they take. **YOUR sword** has devoured **YOUR** prophets, like a lion that is causing ruin. (**Jeremiah 2:30**)
  - On all the beaten paths through the wilderness the despoilers have come. For the **sword** belonging to Yehowah is devouring from one end of the land even to the other end of the land. There is no peace for any flesh. (**Jeremiah 12:12**)
  - And that day belongs to the Sovereign Lord, Yehowah of armies, the day of vengeance for avenging himself upon his adversaries. And the **sword will certainly devour** and satisfy itself and take its fill of their blood, for the Sovereign Lord, Yehowah of armies, has a sacrifice in the land of the north by the river Euphrates. (**Jeremiah 46:10**)
  - And Jeremiah continued on to say to all the people and to all the women; Hear the word of Yehowah, all Judah who are in the land of **Egypt**. (**Jeremiah 44:24**)
  - Tell it among the nations and **publish** it. And lift up a signal, **publish** it. Hide nothing, O **men**. **Say**; Babylon has been captured. Bel has been put to shame. Merodach has become terrified. Her images have been put to shame. Her dungy idols have become terrified. (**Jeremiah 50:2**)
  - Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Here I am bringing upon you a **sword**, and I **will** cut off from you earthling man and domestic animal. (**Ezekiel 29:8**)

- **PUBLISH** it on the dwelling towers in Ashdod and on the dwelling towers in the land of **Egypt**, and say; Be gathered together against the mountains of Samaria, and see the many disorders in the midst of her and cases of defrauding inside her. (**Amos 3:9**)
