Jeremiah 46:14... Tell it in Egypt, O men, and publish it in Migdol, and publish it in Noph¹ and in Tahpanhes. Say, Station yourself, making preparation also for yourself, for a sword will certainly devour all around you.

- The word that occurred to Jeremiah for all the Jews that were dwelling in the land of Egypt, the ones dwelling in Migdol and in Tahpanhes and in Noph and in the land of Pathros, saying; (Jeremiah 44:1)
- Therefore here I am against you and against your Nile canals, and I will make the land of Egypt devastated places, dryness, a desolated waste, from Migdol to Syene and to the boundary of Ethiopia. (Ezekiel 29:10)
- This is what Yehowah has said; The supporters of Egypt must also fall, and the pride of its strength must come down. From Migdol to Syene they will fall in it even by the sword, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (Ezekiel 30:6)
- The princes of Zoan have acted foolishly, the princes of Noph have been deceived, the keymen of her tribes have caused Egypt to wander about. (Isaiah 19:13)
- Even the sons of Noph and Tahpanes themselves kept feeding on you at the crown of the head. (Jeremiah 2:16)
- For, look! They will have to go because of despoiling. Egypt itself will collect them together, Memphis, for its part, will bury them. As for their desirable things of silver, nettles themselves will take possession of them, thorny bushes will be in their tents. (Hosea 9:6)
- And they finally came into the land of Egypt, for they did not obey the voice of Yehowah, and they came gradually as far as Tahpanhes. (Jeremiah 43:7)
- And in Tehaphnehes the day will actually grow dark, when I break there the yoke bars of Egypt. And in her the pride of her strength will actually be made to cease. As for her, clouds

- themselves will cover her, and into captivity her own dependent towns will go. (Ezekiel 30:18)
- Against her they have sanctified war; Rise up, and let us go up at midday! Woe to us, for the day has declined, for the shadows of evening keep extending themselves! (Jeremiah 6:4)
- Proclaim this, you people, among the nations; Sanctify war!

 Arouse the powerful men! Let them draw near! Let them come up, all the men of war! (Joel 3:9)
- Yehowah has a sword, it must be filled with blood, it must be made greasy with the fat, with the blood of young rams and hegoats, with the fat of the kidneys of rams. For Yehowah has a sacrifice in Bozrah, and a great slaughtering in the land of Edom. (Isaiah 34:6)
- To no effect I have struck YOUR sons. No discipline did they take. YOUR sword has devoured YOUR prophets, like a lion that is causing ruin. (Jeremiah 2:30)
- On all the beaten paths through the wilderness the despoilers have come. For the sword belonging to Yehowah is devouring from one end of the land even to the other end of the land. There is no peace for any flesh. (Jeremiah 12:12)
- And that day belongs to the Sovereign Lord, Yehowah of armies, the day of vengeance for avenging himself upon his adversaries. And the sword will certainly devour and satisfy itself and take its fill of their blood, for the Sovereign Lord, Yehowah of armies, has a sacrifice in the land of the north by the river Euphrates. (Jeremiah 46:10)
- And Jeremiah continued on to say to all the people and to all the women; Hear the word of Yehowah, all Judah who are in the land of Egypt. (Jeremiah 44:24)
- Tell it among the nations and publish it. And lift up a signal, publish it. Hide nothing, O men. Say; Babylon has been captured. Bel has been put to shame. Merodach has become terrified. Her images have been put to shame. Her dungy idols have become terrified. (Jeremiah 50:2)
- Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Here I am bringing upon you a sword, and I will cut off from you earthling man and domestic animal. (Ezekiel 29:8)

Publish it on the dwelling towers in Ashdod and on the dwelling towers in the land of Egypt, and say; Be gathered together against the mountains of Samaria, and see the many disorders in the midst of her and cases of defrauding inside her. (Amos 3:9)
