

**Jeremiah 46:27** And as for you, do not be afraid, O my servant Jacob, and do not be terror-stricken, O Israel. For here I am saving you from far away and your offspring from the land of their captivity. And Jacob will certainly return and have no disturbance and be at ease and without anyone causing trembling.

[18] - References:

- For I, Yehowah your God, **am** grasping your right hand, the One saying to you, Do not be afraid. I myself **will** help you. (**Isaiah 41:13**)
- And now this is what Yehowah has said, your Creator, O **Jacob**, and your Former, O **Israel**; Do not be afraid, for I **have** repurchased you. I **have** called you by your name. You are mine. (**Isaiah 43:1**)
- This is what Yehowah has said, your Maker and your Former, who kept helping you even from the belly; Do not be afraid, O my **servant Jacob**, and you, Jeshurun, whom I **have** chosen. (**Isaiah 44:2**)
- And as for you, do not be afraid, O my **servant Jacob**, is the utterance of Yehowah, and do not be struck with terror, O **Israel**. For here I **am saving** you from **far** off and your **offspring** from the **land** of their **captivity**. And **Jacob will certainly return** and be free of **disturbance** and be at **ease**, and there **will** be no one **causing** trembling. (**Jeremiah 30:10**)
- And it must occur in that day that Yehowah **will** again offer his hand, a second time, to acquire the remnant of his people who **will** remain over from Assyria and from Egypt and from Pathros and from Cush and from Elam and from Shinar and from Hamath and from the islands of the sea. (**Isaiah 11:11**)
- And I myself shall collect together the remnant of my sheep out of all the **lands** to which I had dispersed them, and I **will** bring them back to their pasture ground, and they **will certainly** be fruitful and become many. (**Jeremiah 23:3**)
- Here I **am** collecting them together out of all the **lands** to which I shall **have** dispersed them in my anger and in my rage and in great indignation, and I **will** bring them back to this place and make them dwell in security. (**Jeremiah 32:37**)

- When I bring them back from the peoples and I actually collect them together out of the **lands** of their enemies, I **will** also sanctify myself among them before the eyes of many nations. (**Ezekiel 39:27**)
- And I **will** gather back the captive ones of my people **Israel**, and they **will** actually build the desolated cities and inhabit them, and plant vineyards and drink the wine of them, and make gardens and eat the fruit of them. (**Amos 9:14**)
- In his days Judah **will** be saved, and **Israel** itself **will** reside in security. And this is his name with which he **will** be called, Yehowah Is Our Righteousness. (**Jeremiah 23:6**)
- In those days Judah **will** be saved and Jerusalem itself **will** reside in security. And this is what she **will** be called, Yehowah Is Our Righteousness. (**Jeremiah 33:16**)
- And I **will** bring **Israel** back to his pasture ground, and he **will** **certainly** graze on Carmel and on Bashan, and in the mountainous region of Ephraim and of Gilead his soul **will** be satisfied. (**Jeremiah 50:19**)
- And it must become a region for the remaining ones of the house of Judah. Upon them they **will** feed. In the houses of Ashkelon, in the evening, they **will** lie stretched out. For Yehowah their God **will** turn his attention to them and **certainly** gather back the captive ones of them. (**Zephaniah 2:7**)
- At that time I shall bring **you** people in, even in the time of my collecting **you** together. For I shall make **you** people to be a name and a praise among all the peoples of the earth, when I gather back **your** captive ones before **your** eyes, Yehowah has said. (**Zephaniah 3:20**)
- But this is what Yehowah has said; Even the body of captives of the mighty man **will** be taken **away**, and those already taken by the tyrant himself **will** make their escape. And against **anyone** contending against you I myself shall contend, and your own sons I myself shall save. (**Isaiah 49:25**)
- For I **am** with you, is the utterance of Yehowah, to save you, but I shall make an extermination among all the nations to which I **have** scattered you. However, in your case I shall make no extermination. And I shall **have** to correct you to the proper

degree, as I shall by no means leave you unpunished. (**Jeremiah 30:11**)

- And there exists a hope for your future, is the utterance of Yehowah; and the sons **will certainly return** to their own territory. (**Jeremiah 31:17**)
- And they **will** no longer become something to plunder for the nations, and as regards the wild beast of the earth, it **will** not devour them, and they **will** actually dwell in security, with no one to make them tremble. (**Ezekiel 34:28**)
