

Jeremiah 46:28 As for you, do not be afraid, O my servant Jacob, is the utterance of Yehowah, for I am with you. For I shall make an extermination among all the nations to which I have dispersed you, but with you I shall make no extermination. Yet I shall have to chastise you to the proper degree, and I shall absolutely not leave you unpunished.

[20] - References:

- **Yehowah** of armies is with us, the God of Jacob is a secure height for us. (**Psalms 46:7**)
- In case you should pass through the waters, I will be with you, and through the rivers, they will not flood over you. In case you should walk through the fire, you will not be scorched, neither will the flame itself singe you. (**Isaiah 43:2**)
- And they will be certain to fight against you, but they will not prevail against you, for, I **am** with you, is the **utterance** of **Yehowah**, to deliver you. (**Jeremiah 1:19**)
- And I **have** made you to this people a fortified copper wall, and they will certainly fight against you, but they will not prevail over you. For I **am** with you, to save you and to deliver you, is the **utterance** of **Yehowah**. (**Jeremiah 15:20**)
- And as for you, do not be afraid, O my **servant** Jacob, is the **utterance** of **Yehowah**, and do not be struck with terror, O Israel. For here I **am** saving you from far off and your offspring from the land of their captivity. And Jacob will certainly return and be free of disturbance and be at ease, and there will be no one causing trembling. (**Jeremiah 30:10**)
- What, then, shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who will be against us? (**Romans 8:31**)
- Here I **am** sending and I will take all the families of the north, is the **utterance** of **Yehowah**, even sending to Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon, my **servant**, and I will bring them against this land and against its inhabitants and against all these **nations** round about, and I will devote them to destruction and **make** them an object of astonishment and something to whistle at and places devastated to time indefinite. (**Jeremiah 25:9**)

- Come up against her vine rows and cause ruin, but do not **you** men **make** an actual **extermination**. Take away her luxuriating shoots, for they do not belong to **Yehowah**. (**Jeremiah 5:10**)
- For I **am** with you, is the **utterance** of **Yehowah**, to save you, but I shall **make** an **extermination among** all the **nations** to which I **have** scattered you. However, in your case I shall **make** no **extermination**. And I shall **have** to correct you to the **proper degree**, as I shall by no means **leave** you unpunished. (**Jeremiah 30:11**)
- Look! The eyes of the Sovereign Lord **Yehowah** are upon the sinful kingdom, and he will certainly annihilate it from upon the surface of the ground. Nevertheless, I shall not completely annihilate the house of **Jacob**, is the **utterance** of **Yehowah**. (**Amos 9:8**)
- Correct me, O **Yehowah**, however with judgment, not in your anger, that you may not reduce me to nothing. (**Jeremiah 10:24**)
- However, when we are judged, we are disciplined by **Yehowah**, that we may not become condemned with the world. (**1 Corinthians 11:32**)
- But **you** **have** entirely forgotten the exhortation which addresses **you** as sons; My son, do not belittle the discipline from **Yehowah**, neither give out when you are corrected by him. (**Hebrews 12:5**)
- All those for whom I **have** affection I reprove and discipline. Therefore be zealous and repent. (**Revelation 3:19**)
- O **Yehowah**, do not in your anger reprove me, and do not in your rage correct me. (**Psalms 6:1**)
- O **Yehowah** our God, you yourself answered them. A God granting pardon you proved to be to them, and executing vengeance against their notorious deeds. (**Psalms 99:8**)
- For this is what **Yehowah** has said; Look! Although it is not their custom to drink the cup, they will drink without fail. And you yourself, will you be **absolutely** left unpunished? You will not be left unpunished, for you will drink without fail. (**Jeremiah 49:12**)
- For Israel and Judah are not widowed from their God, from **Yehowah** of armies. For the land of those has been full of guilt from the standpoint of the Holy One of Israel. (**Jeremiah 51:5**)

- **Yehowah** is slow to anger and great in power, and by no means will **Yehowah** hold back from punishing. In destructive wind and in storm is his way, and the cloud mass is the powder of his feet. (**Nahum 1:3**)
- In that day it will be said to Jerusalem; Do not be afraid, O Zion. May your hands not drop down. (**Zephaniah 3:16**)
