- After that Judah captured **Gaza** and its territory and **Ashkelon** and its territory and Ekron and its territory. (**Judges 1:18**)
- And Yehowah's spirit became operative upon him, so that he went down to **Ashkelon** and struck down thirty men of theirs and took what he stripped off them and gave the outfits to the tellers of the riddle. And his anger continued hot, and he went his way up to his father's house. (**Judges 14:19**)
- And all the mixed company, and all the kings of the land of Uz, and all the kings of the land of the Philistines and **Ashkelon** and **Gaza** and Ekron and the **remnant** of Ashdod. (**Jeremiah 25:20**)
- For upon every head there is baldness, and every beard is clipped. Upon all hands there are **cuts**, and upon the hips there is sackcloth! (**Jeremiah 48:37**)
- And I **will** cut off the inhabitant from Ashdod, and the holder of the scepter from **Ashkelon**, and I **will** turn my hand back upon Ekron, and the remaining ones of the Philistines **must** perish, the Sovereign Lord Yehowah **has** said. (**Amos 1:8**)
- For, as regards **Gaza**, an abandoned city is what she **will** become, and **Ashkelon** is to be a desolate waste. As regards Ashdod, at high noon they **will** drive her out, and as regards Ekron, she **will** be uprooted. (**Zephaniah 2:4**)
- He **has** gone up to The House and to Dibon, to the high places, to a weeping. Over Nebo and over Medeba Moab itself howls. On all heads in it there is baldness, every beard is clipped. (**Isaiah 15:2**)
- For, as regards **Gaza**, an abandoned city is what she **will** become, and **Ashkelon** is to be a desolate waste. As regards Ashdod, at high noon they **will** drive her out, and as regards Ekron, she **will** be uprooted. (**Zephaniah 2:4**)

- And all the mixed company, and all the kings of the land of Uz, and all the kings of the land of the Philistines and **Ashkelon** and **Gaza** and Ekron and the **remnant** of Ashdod. (**Jeremiah 25:20**)
- **Ashkelon will** see and get afraid, and as for **Gaza**, she **will** also feel very severe pains, Ekron also, because her looked-for hope **will** have to experience shame. And a king **will** certainly perish from **Gaza**, and **Ashkelon** herself **will** not be inhabited. (**Zechariah 9:5**)
- They should not produce baldness upon their heads, and the extremity of their beard they should not shave, and on their flesh they should not make an incision. (**Leviticus 21:5**)
- Sons **you** are of Yehowah **your** God. **You must** not make cuttings upon yourselves or impose baldness on **your** foreheads for a dead person. (**Deuteronomy 14:1**)
- And they **will** certainly die, the great ones and the small ones, in this land. They **will** not be buried, neither **will** people beat themselves for them, nor **will** anyone make **cuts** upon himself or make himself bald for them. (**Jeremiah 16:6**)
