Jeremiah 48:10... Cursed be the one that is carrying out the mission of Yehowah neglectfully, and cursed be the one that is holding back his sword from blood!

- So Moses said to them; Have YOU preserved alive every female? (Numbers 31:15)
- Curse Meroz, said the angel of Yehowah; Curse its inhabitants incessantly, for they did not come to the assistance of Yehowah, to the assistance of Yehowah with the mighty ones. (Judges 5:23)
- So why is it you did not obey the voice of Yehowah but went darting greedily at the spoil and doing what was bad in the eyes of Yehowah? (1 Samuel 15:19)
- He now said to him; This is what Yehowah has said, For the reason that you have let go out of your hand the man devoted to me for destruction, your soul must take the place of his soul, and your people the place of his people. (1 Kings 20:42)
- And the Asherites continued to dwell in among the Canaanites inhabiting the land, because they did not drive them out. (Judges 1:32)
- But Saul and the people had compassion upon Agag and upon the best of the flock and the herd and the fat ones and upon the rams and upon all that was good, and they did not wish to devote them to destruction. As for all the goods that were despicable and rejected, these they devoted to destruction. (1 Samuel 15:9)
- However, Saul said to Samuel; But I have obeyed the voice of Yehowah in that I went on the mission on which Yehowah had sent me and I brought Agag the king of Amalek, but Amalek I have devoted to destruction. (1 Samuel 15:20)
- As you did not obey the voice of Yehowah, and you did not execute his burning anger against Amalek, that is why this is the thing that Yehowah will certainly do to you this day. (1 Samuel 28:18)
- And let it occur that, when you hear the sound of a marching in the tops of the baca bushes, at that time you act with decision,

- because at that time Yehowah will have gone out ahead of you to strike down the camp of the Philistines. (2 Samuel 5:24)
