Jeremiah 48:13... And the Moabites will have to be ashamed of Chemosh, just as those of the house of Israel have become ashamed of Bethel their confidence.

- Is it not whomever Chemosh your god causes you to dispossess that you will dispossess? And every one whom Yehowah our God has dispossessed from before us is the one we shall dispossess. (Judges 11:24)
- It was then that Solomon proceeded to build a high place to Chemosh the disgusting thing of Moab on the mountain that was in front of Jerusalem, and to Molech the disgusting thing of the sons of Ammon. (1 Kings 11:7)
- They will certainly be ashamed and even be humiliated, all of them. Together in humiliation the manufacturers of idol forms will have to walk. (Isaiah 45:16)
- Then he placed the one in **Bethel**, and the other he put in Dan. (1 Kings 12:29)
- In this way one will certainly do to you people, O Bethel, because of your extreme badness. In the dawn the king of Israel will positively have to be silenced. (Hosea 10:15)
- And do not search for Bethel, and to Gilgal you must not come, and to Beer-sheba you must not pass over, because Gilgal itself will without fail go into exile, and as regards Bethel, it will become something uncanny. (Amos 5:5)
- And she was dwelling under Deborah's palm tree between Ramah and Bethel in the mountainous region of Ephraim, and the sons of Israel would go up to her for judgment. (Judges 4:5)
- The reason why is that they have left me and begun to bow down to Ashtoreth the goddess of the Sidonians, to Chemosh the god of Moab and to Milcom the god of the sons of Ammon, and they have not walked in my ways by doing what is right in my eyes and my statutes and my judicial decisions like David his father. (1 Kings 11:33)
- And the high places that were in front of Jerusalem, that were to the right of the Mount of Ruination, that Solomon the king of

Israel had built to Ashtoreth the disgusting thing of the Sidonians and to Chemosh the disgusting thing of Moab and to Milcom the detestable thing of the sons of Ammon, the king made unfit for worship. (2 Kings 23:13)

Even it someone will bring to Assyria itself as a gift to a great king. Shame is what Ephraim himself will get, and Israel will be ashamed of its counsel. (Hosea 10:6)
