- And now Yehowah has spoken, saying; Within three years, according to the years of a hired laborer, the glory of Moab must also be disgraced with much commotion of every sort, and those who remain over will be a trifling few, not mighty. (Isaiah 16:14)
- And the despoiler will come in on every city, and there will be no city that can make its escape. And the low plain will certainly perish and the level land be annihilated, a thing that Yehowah has said. (Jeremiah 48:8)
- For Yehowah has indignation against all the nations, and rage against all their army. He must devote them to destruction, he must give them to the slaughter. (Isaiah 34:2)
- Who, then, is this glorious King? Yehowah strong and mighty, Yehowah mighty in battle. (Psalms 24:8)
- As I am alive, is the utterance of the King, whose name is Yehowah of armies; Like Tabor among the mountains and like Carmel by the sea he will come in. (Jeremiah 46:18)
- Now I, Nebuchadnezzar, am praising and exalting and glorifying the King of the heavens, because all his works are truth and his ways are justice, and because those who are walking in pride he is able to humiliate. (Daniel 4:37)
- And cursed is the one acting cunningly when there exists in his drove a male animal, and he is making a vow and sacrificing a ruined one to Yehowah. For I am a great King, Yehowah of armies has said, and my name will be fear-inspiring among the nations. (Malachi 1:14)
- And I will make her princes and her wise ones, her governors and her deputy rulers and her mighty men drunk, and they must sleep an indefinitely lasting sleep, from which they will not wake up, is the utterance of the King, whose name is Yehowah of armies. (Jeremiah 51:57)

- **And it must occur that, as regards everyone who is left remaining out of all the nations that are coming **against** Jerusalem, they must also go up from year to year to bow **down** to the **King**, **Yehowah** of **armies**, and to celebrate the festival of the booths. (Zechariah 14:16)**
