

Jeremiah 48:18 **Get down from glory, and sit down in thirst, O inhabitress of the daughter of Dibon, for the despoiler of Moab has come up against you. He will ctually bring your fortified places to ruin.**

[7] - References:

- Come **down** and **sit down** in the dust, O virgin **daughter** of Babylon. Sit **down** on the earth where there is no throne, O **daughter** of the Chaldeans. For you **will** not experience again that people call you delicate and dainty. (**Isaiah 47:1**)
- Make for yourself mere baggage for exile, O **inhabitress**, the **daughter** of Egypt. For Noph itself **will** become a mere object of astonishment and **will** actually be set afire, so as to be without an inhabitant. (**Jeremiah 46:19**)
- So let us shoot at them. Heshbon **will** certainly perish up to **Dibon**; And the women up to Nophah, the men up to Medeba. (**Numbers 21:30**)
- Heshbon and all its towns that are on the tableland, **Dibon** and Bamoth-baal and Beth-baal-meon. (**Joshua 13:17**)
- He **has** gone up to The House and to **Dibon**, to the high **places**, to a weeping. Over Nebo and over Medeba **Moab** itself howls. On all heads in it there is baldness, every beard is clipped. (**Isaiah 15:2**)
- And the **despoiler will come** in on every city, and there **will** be no city that can make its escape. And the low plain **will** certainly perish and the level land be annihilated, a thing that Yehowah **has** said. (**Jeremiah 48:8**)
- And **against Dibon** and **against** Nebo and **against** Beth-diblathaim. (**Jeremiah 48:22**)
