

Jeremiah 48:33 And rejoicing and joyfulness have been taken away from the orchard and from the land of Moab. And from the winepresses I have caused the wine itself to cease. No one will be doing the treading with shouting. The shouting will be no shouting.

- And I **will** destroy out of them the sound of exultation and the sound of rejoicing, the voice of the bridegroom and the voice of the bride, the sound of the hand mill and the light of the lamp. (**Jeremiah 25:10**)
- The vine itself has shown dryness, and even the fig tree has faded **away**. As for the pomegranate tree, also the palm tree and the apple tree, all the trees of the field, they **have** dried up, for exultation has gone ashamed **away** from the sons of mankind. (**Joel 1:12**)
- For even ten acres of vineyard **will** produce but one bath measure, and even a homer measure of seed **will** produce but an ephah measure. (**Isaiah 5:10**)
- And it must occur in that day that every place where there used to be a thousand vines, worth a thousand pieces of silver, **will** come to be, for the thornbushes and for the weeds it **will** come to be. (**Isaiah 7:23**)
- And rejoicing and **joyfulness have** been **taken away** from the **orchard**, and in the vineyards there is no joyful crying out, there is no **shouting** done. No **wine** in the presses does the treader tread out. Shouting I **have caused** to **cease**. (**Isaiah 16:10**)
- And as for you, you **will** prophesy to them all these words, and you must say to them; From on high Yehowah himself **will** roar, and from his holy dwelling he **will** give forth his voice. Without fail he **will** roar upon his abiding place. A shout like that of those **treading** the winepress he **will** sing out against all the inhabitants of the earth. (**Jeremiah 25:30**)
- And they went out as usual into the field and engaged in gathering the grapes of their vineyards and in **treading** them and in carrying on a festal exultation, after which they went into the house of their god and ate and drank and called down evil upon Abimelech. (**Judges 9:27**)

- You **will** certainly give a rejoicing in my heart greater than in the time when their grain and their new **wine have** abounded. (**Psalms 4:7**)
- And in all vineyards there **will** be wailing, for I shall pass through the midst of you, Yehowah has said. (**Amos 5:17**)
