Jeremiah 48:34... From the cry in Heshbon clear to Elealeh, clear to Jahaz they have given forth their voice, from Zoar clear to Horonaim, to Eglath-shelishiyah, for even the waters of Nimrim themselves will become mere desolations.

- So Israel took all these cities, and Israel began dwelling in all the cities of the Amorites, in Heshbon and all its dependent towns.

 (Numbers 21:25)
- Heshbon and all its towns that are on the tableland, Dibon and Bamoth-baal and Beth-baal-meon. (Joshua 13:17)
- No more is there any praise of Moab. In Heshbon they have thought out against her a calamity; Come, men, and let us cut her off from being a nation. You, too, O Madmen, should keep silent. After you there walks a sword. (Jeremiah 48:2)
- And the sons of Reuben built Heshbon and Elealeh and Kiriathaim. (Numbers 32:37)
- That is why I shall weep with the weeping of Jazer over the vine of Sibmah. With my tears I shall drench you, O Heshbon and Elealeh, because shouting even over your summer and over your harvest has fallen down. (Isaiah 16:9)
- And Sihon did not allow Israel to pass through his territory, but Sihon gathered all his people and went out to meet Israel in the wilderness, and came to Jahaz and began fighting with Israel. (Numbers 21:23)
- When Sihon came on out, he and all his people, to meet us in battle at Jahaz. (Deuteronomy 2:32)
- And Sihon did not feel sure about Israel's crossing through his territory, and Sihon went gathering all his people together and camping in Jahaz and fighting against Israel. (Judges 11:20)
- And Heshbon and Elealeh cry out. As far as Yahaz their voice has been heard. That is why the armed men of Moab themselves keep shouting. His very soul has quivered within him. (Isaiah 15:4)

- And the Negeb and the District, the valley plain of Jericho, the city of the palm trees, as far as Zoar. (Deuteronomy 34:3)
- There is the sound of an outcry from Horonaim, a despoiling and great breaking down. (Jeremiah 48:3)
- My own heart cries out over Moab himself. The runaways thereof are as far along as Zoar and Eglath-shelishiyah. For on the ascent of Luhith, with weeping each one goes up on it, for on the way to Horonaim they arouse the outcry about the catastrophe. (Isaiah 15:5)
- For the very waters of Nimrim become sheer desolations. For the green grass has dried up, the grass has come to an end, nothing has become green. (Isaiah 15:6)
- Ataroth and Dibon and Jazer and Nimrah and Heshbon and Elealeh and Sebam and Nebo and Beon. (Numbers 32:3)
