

Jeremiah 48:36 **That is why my own heart will be boisterous for Moab himself, just like flutes, and for the men of Kir-heres my very heart will be boisterous, just like flutes. That is why the very abundance that he has produced will certainly perish.**

[8] - References:

- **My own heart** cries out over **Moab** himself. The runaways thereof are as far along as Zoar and Eglath-shelishiyah. For on the ascent of Luhith, with weeping each one goes up on it, for on the way to Horonaim they arouse the outcry about the catastrophe. (**Isaiah 15:5**)
- That is **why** my very inwards are **boisterous just** like a harp even over **Moab**, and the midst of me over Kir-hareseth. (**Isaiah 16:11**)
- When, now, he came into the ruler's house and caught sight of the flute players and the crowd in noisy confusion. (**Matthew 9:23**)
- That is **why** it is over **Moab** that I shall howl, and for **Moab** in his entirety I shall cry out. For the **men** of Kirheres one shall moan. (**Jeremiah 48:31**)
- Valuable things **will** be of no benefit on the day of fury, but righteousness itself **will** deliver from death. (**Proverbs 11:4**)
- The valuable things of the rich are his strong town, and they are like a protective wall in his imagination. (**Proverbs 18:11**)
- That is **why** the leftovers and their stored goods that they have put up, they keep carrying them away right over the torrent valley of the poplars. (**Isaiah 15:7**)
- As the partridge that **has** gathered together what it **has** not laid is the one making riches, but not with justice. At the half of his days he **will** leave them, and in his finale he **will** prove to be senseless. (**Jeremiah 17:11**)
