[8] - References:

- And people have **become** disturbed. Convulsions and birth pains themselves grab hold, like a woman that is giving birth they have labor pains. They look at each other in amazement. Their faces are inflamed faces. (**Isaiah 13:8**)
- That is why my hips have **become** full of severe pains. Convulsions themselves have grabbed hold of me, like the convulsions of a woman that is giving birth. I have **become** disconcerted so that I do not hear, I have **become** disturbed so that I do not see. (**Isaiah 21:3**)
- Look! Just like an eagle someone **will** ascend and pounce down, and he **will** spread out his wings over Bozrah, and the **heart** of the **mighty men** of Edom **will actually become** in that **day** like the **heart** of the **wife** having distress in childbirth. (**Jeremiah 49:22**)
- Now why is it that you keep shouting loudly? Is there no king in you, or has your **own** counselor perished, so that pangs like those of a woman giving birth have grabbed hold of you? (**Micah 4:9**)
- Whenever it is that they are saying; Peace and security! Then sudden destruction is to be instantly upon them just as the pang of distress upon a pregnant woman, and they **will** by no means escape. (**1 Thessalonians 5:3**)
- Here I am bringing in upon you a dreadful thing, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord, Yehowah of armies, from all those round about you. And **you** people **will certainly** be dispersed, each one in his **own** direction, and there **will** be no one collecting together those running away. (**Jeremiah 49:5**)
- Damascus has lost courage. She has turned to flee, and sheer panic has **seized** her. Distress and birth pangs themselves have taken hold of her, as with a woman that is giving birth. (**Jeremiah 49:24**)

- The great **day** of Yehowah is near. It is near, and there is a hurrying of it very much. The sound of the **day** of Yehowah is bitter. There a **mighty** man is letting out a cry. (**Zephaniah 1:14**)
