Jeremiah 49:10... But as for me, I will strip Esau bare. I will uncover his places of concealment, and one will not be able to hide oneself. His offspring and his brothers and his neighbors will certainly be despoiled, and he will not be.

- O the extent to which those of Esau have been searched out! How his concealed treasures have been sought out! (Obadiah 1:6)
- And Esau I have hated, and I finally made his mountains a desolated waste and his inheritance for the jackals of the wilderness. (Malachi 1:3)
- Or can any man be concealed in places of concealment and I myself not see him? Is the utterance of Yehowah. Is it not the heavens and the earth that I myself actually fill? Is the utterance of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 23:24)
- And if they hide themselves on the top of Carmel, from there I shall carefully search and be certain to take them. And if they conceal themselves from in front of my eyes on the floor of the sea, down there I shall command the serpent, and it must bite them. (Amos 9:3)
- And your mighty men must become terrified, O Teman, for the reason that each one will be cut off from the mountainous region of Esau, because of a killing. (Obadiah 1:9)
- At evening time, why, look! There is sudden terror. Before morning, it is no more. This is the share of those pillaging us, and the lot belonging to those plundering us. (Isaiah 17:14)
- Exult and rejoice, O daughter of Edom, dwelling as you do in the land of Uz. To you also the cup will pass along. You will become drunk and show yourself in nakedness. (Lamentations 4:21)
