

Jeremiah 49:11· **Do leave your fatherless boys. I myself shall preserve them alive, and your own widows will trust even in me.**

[6] - References:

- Be judges for the lowly one and the **fatherless** boy. To the afflicted one and the one of little means do justice. (**Psalms 82:3**)
- A father of **fatherless boys** and a judge of **widows** is God in his holy dwelling. (**Psalms 68:5**)
- Assyria itself **will** not save us. Upon horses we shall not ride. And no more shall we say; O our God! To the work of our hands, because it is by you that a **fatherless** boy is shown mercy. (**Hosea 14:3**)
- The form of worship that is clean and undefiled from the standpoint of our God and Father is this. To look after orphans and **widows** in their tribulation, and to keep oneself without spot from the world. (**James 1:27**)
- For you yourself have seen trouble and vexation. You keep looking on, to get them into your hand. To you the unfortunate one, the **fatherless** boy, commits himself. You yourself have become his helper. (**Psalms 10:14**)
- Now the woman who is actually a widow and left destitute has put her hope in God and persists in supplications and prayers night and day. (**1 Timothy 5:5**)
