Yehowah, and I will cause the alarm signal of war to be heard even against Rabbah of the sons of Ammon, and she will certainly become a mound of a desolate waste, and her dependent towns¹ themselves will be set aflame in the very fire. And Israel will actually take possession of those in possession of him, Yehowah has said.

- O my intestines, my intestines! I am in severe pains in the walls of my heart. My heart is boisterous within me. I cannot keep silent, for the sound of the horn is what my soul has heard, the alarm signal of war. (Jeremiah 4:19)
- For only Og the king of Bashan remained of what was left of the Rephaim. Look! His bier was a bier of iron. Is it not in Rabbah of the sons of Ammon? Nine cubits is its length, and four cubits its width, by the cubit of a man. (Deuteronomy 3:11)
- And their territory came to be Jazer and all the cities of Gilead and half of the land of the sons of Ammon as far as Aroer, which is in front of Rabbah. (Joshua 13:25)
- A way you should set for the sword to enter against Rabbah of the sons of Ammon, and one against Judah, against Jerusalem fortified. (Ezekiel 21:20)
- So Israel took all these cities, and Israel began dwelling in all the cities of the Amorites, in Heshbon and all its dependent towns.

 (Numbers 21:25)
- And there came to belong to Manasseh in Issachar and in Asher Beth-shean and its dependent towns and Ibleam and its dependent towns and the inhabitants of Dor and its dependent towns and the inhabitants of En-dor and its dependent towns and the inhabitants of Taanach and its dependent towns and the inhabitants of Megiddo and its dependent towns, three of the heights. (Joshua 17:11)
- Therefore, as I am alive, is the utterance of Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, Moab herself will become just like Sodom, and the sons of Ammon like Gomorrah, a place possessed by nettles,

- and a salt pit, and a desolate waste, even to time indefinite. The remaining ones of my people will plunder them, and the remnant of my own nation will take possession of them. (Zephaniah 2:9)
- And peoples will actually take them and bring them to their own place, and the house of Israel must take them to themselves as a possession upon the soil of Yehowah as menservants and as maidservants, and they must become the captors of those holding them captive, and they must have in subjection those who were driving them to work. (Isaiah 14:2)
- And I will bring Israel back to his pasture ground, and he will certainly graze on Carmel and on Bashan, and in the mountainous region of Ephraim and of Gilead his soul will be satisfied. (Jeremiah 50:19)
- Shepherd your people with your staff, the flock of your inheritance, the one who was residing alone in a forest, in the midst of an orchard. Let them feed on Bashan and Gilead as in the days of a long time ago. (Micah 7:14)
- And all its spoil you should collect into the middle of its public square, and you must burn in the fire the city and all its spoil as a whole offering to Yehowah your God, and it must become a heap of ruins to time indefinite. It should never be rebuilt.

 (Deuteronomy 13:16)
- Gebal and Ammon and Amalek, Philistia together with the inhabitants of Tyre. (Psalms 83:7)
- And they must fly at the shoulder of the Philistines to the west, together they will plunder the sons of the East. Edom and Moab will be those upon whom they will thrust out their hand, and the sons of Ammon will be their subjects. (Isaiah 11:14)
- This is what Yehowah has said against all my bad neighbors, who are touching the hereditary possession that I caused my people, even Israel, to possess; Here I am uprooting them from off their ground, and the house of Judah I shall uproot from the midst of them. (Jeremiah 12:14)
- And you, O son of man, prophesy, and you must say; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said concerning the sons of Ammon and concerning the reproach from them. And you must say, A sword, a sword drawn for a slaughter, polished to cause it to devour, in order to glitter. (Ezekiel 21:28)

- For the fire you will become fuel. Your own blood will prove to be in the midst of the land. You will not be remembered, for I myself, Yehowah, have spoken. (Ezekiel 21:32)
- Therefore here I am; I have stretched out my hand against you, and I will give you as something to plunder to the nations, and I will cut you off from the peoples and destroy you from the lands. I shall annihilate you, and you will have to know that I am Yehowah. (Ezekiel 25:7)
- And I will bring my vengeance on Edom by the hand of my people Israel, and they must do in Edom according to my anger and according to my rage, and they will have to know what my vengeance is, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (Ezekiel 25:14)
- And I will set fire to the wall of Rabbah, and it must devour her dwelling towers, with an alarm signal in the day of battle, with a tempest in the day of storm wind. (Amos 1:14)
