Jeremiah 49:23... For Damascus! Hamath and Arpad have become ashamed, for it is a bad report that they have heard. They have disintegrated. In the sea there is anxious care, it is not able to keep undisturbed.

- The pronouncement against Damascus! Look! Damascus removed from being a city, and she has become a heap, a decaying ruin. (Isaiah 17:1)
- This is what Yehowah has said; On account of three revolts of Damascus, and on account of four, I shall not turn it back, on account of their threshing Gilead even with iron threshing instruments. (Amos 1:3)
- So they went up and spied out the land from the wilderness of Zin to Rehob to the entering in of Hamath. (Numbers 13:21)
- Subsequently the king of Assyria brought people from Babylon and Cuthah and Avva and Hamath and Sepharvaim and had them dwell in the cities of Samaria instead of the sons of Israel, and they began to take possession of Samaria and to dwell in its cities. (2 Kings 17:24)
- Is not Calno just like Carchemish? Is not Hamath just like Arpad? Is not Samaria just like Damascus? (Isaiah 10:9)
- And Hamath itself will also border upon her, Tyre and Sidon, for she is very wise. (Zechariah 9:2)
- Where are the gods of Hamath and Arpad? Where are the gods of Sepharvaim, Hena and Ivvah? Have they delivered Samaria out of my hand? (2 Kings 18:34)
- When we got to hear it, then our hearts began to melt, and no spirit has arisen yet in anybody because of YOU, for Yehowah YOUR God is God in the heavens above and on the earth beneath.

 (Joshua 2:11)
- But the wicked are like the sea that is being tossed, when it is unable to calm down, the waters of which keep tossing up seaweed and mire. (Isaiah 57:20)
