

**Jeremiah 49:29** **• Their own tents and their own flocks will be taken, their tent cloths and all their articles. And their own camels will be carried off from them. And they will certainly cry out to them; Fright is all around!**

[8] - References:

- Woe to me, for I have resided as an alien in Meshech! I have tabernacled together with the **tents** of Kedar. (**Psalms 120:5**)
- All the **flocks** of Kedar, they **will** be collected together to you. The rams of Nebaioth, they **will** minister to you. With approval they **will** come up upon my altar, and I shall beautify my **own** house of beauty. (**Isaiah 60:7**)
- Under what is hurtful I saw the **tents** of Cushan. The **tent cloths** of the land of Midian began to be agitated. (**Habakkuk 3:7**)
- For they and their livestock would come up with their **tents**. They would come as numerous as the locusts, and they and their **camels** were without number, and they would come into the land to ruin it. (**Judges 6:5**)
- For I have heard the bad report by many, fright being on all sides. When they mass together as one against me, it is to take away my soul that they do scheme. (**Psalms 31:13**)
- Do not go **out** into the field, and do not walk even in the way, for there is the sword belonging to the enemy, there is fright all **around**. (**Jeremiah 6:25**)
- Why is it that I have seen them terror-stricken? They are turning back, and their mighty men themselves are crushed to pieces, and they have positively fled, and they have not turned **around**. There is fright all around, is the utterance of Yehowah. (**Jeremiah 46:5**)
- But it came about on the following day that Pashhur proceeded to let Jeremiah **out** from the stocks, and Jeremiah now said to him; Yehowah has called your name, not Pashhur, but Fright all **around**. (**Jeremiah 20:3**)
