Jeremiah 4:10. And I proceeded to say; Alas, O Sovereign Lord Yehowah!

Truly you have absolutely deceived this people and Jerusalem, saying; Peace itself will become yours, and the sword has reached clear to the soul. 1

- There was a hoping for peace, but no good came, for a time of healing, but, look! Terror! (Jeremiah 8:15)
