Jeremiah 4:15... For a voice is telling from Dan and is publishing something hurtful from the mountainous region of Ephraim.

- Furthermore, they called the name of the city Dan by the name of their father, Dan, who had been born to Israel. Nevertheless, Laish was the city's name at first. (Judges 18:29)
- Consequently all the sons of Israel went out and the assembly congregated themselves as one man, from Dan down to Beersheba along with the land of Gilead, to Yehowah at Mizpah. (Judges 20:1)
- From Dan has been heard the snorting of his horses. Due to the sound of the neighing of his stallions the whole land has begun to rock. And they come in and eat up the land and what fills it, the city and its inhabitants. (Jeremiah 8:16)
- At this Joshua said to them; If you are a numerous people, go your way up to the forest, and you must cut it down for yourself there in the land of the Perizzites and the Rephaim, because the mountainous region of Ephraim has become too narrow for you. (Joshua 17:15)
- Accordingly they gave a sacred status to Kedesh in Galilee in the mountainous region of Naphtali, and Shechem in the mountainous region of Ephraim, and Kiriath-arba, that is to say, Hebron, in the mountainous region of Judah. (Joshua 20:7)
- There was a hoping for peace, but no good came, for a time of healing, but, look! Terror! (Jeremiah 8:15)
