Jeremiah 4:16" Make mention of it, you people, yes, to the nations. Publish it against Jerusalem. Watchers are coming from a land far away, and they will let out their voice against the very cities of Judah.

- And you will have to serve your enemies whom Yehowah will send against you with hunger and thirst and nakedness and the want of everything, and he will certainly put an iron yoke upon your neck until he has annihilated you. (Deuteronomy 28:48)
- After that Isaiah the prophet came in to King Hezekiah and said to him; What did these men say, and from where did they proceed to come to you? So Hezekiah said; From a distant land they came to me, from Babylon. (Isaiah 39:3)
- For here I am calling for all the families of the kingdoms of the north, is the utterance of Yehowah, and they will certainly come and place each one his throne at the entrance of the gates of Jerusalem, and against all her walls round about and against all the cities of Judah. (Jeremiah 1:15)
- Here I am bringing in upon YOU men a nation from far away, O house of Israel, is the utterance of Yehowah. It is an enduring nation. It is a nation of long ago, a nation whose language you do not know, and you cannot hear understandingly what they speak. (Jeremiah 5:15)
- Take for yourself a roll of a book, and you must write in it all the words that I have spoken to you against Israel and against Judah and against all the nations, since the day that I spoke to you, since the days of Josiah, clear down to this day. (Jeremiah 36:2)
- Tell it among the nations and publish it. And lift up a signal, publish it. Hide nothing, O men. Say, Babylon has been captured. Bel has been put to shame. Merodach has become terrified. Her images have been put to shame. Her dungy idols have become terrified. (Jeremiah 50:2)
