- And you **will** have to serve your enemies whom Yehowah **will** send **against** you with hunger and thirst and nakedness and the want of everything, and he **will** certainly put an iron yoke upon your neck until he has annihilated you. (**Deuteronomy 28:48**)
- After that Isaiah the prophet came in to King Hezekiah and said to him; What did these men say, and from where did they proceed to come to you? So Hezekiah said; From a distant **land** they came to me, from Babylon. (**Isaiah 39:3**)
- For here I am calling for all the families of the kingdoms of the north, is the utterance of Yehowah, and they **will** certainly come and place each one his throne at the entrance of the gates of Jerusalem, and **against** all her walls round about and **against** all the **cities** of **Judah**. (**Jeremiah 1:15**)
- Here I am bringing in upon **you** men a nation from **far away**, O house of Israel, is the utterance of Yehowah. It is an enduring nation. It is a nation of long ago, a nation whose language you do not know, and you cannot hear understandingly what they speak. (**Jeremiah 5:15**)
- Take for yourself a roll of a book, and you must write in it all the words that I have spoken to you **against** Israel and **against** **Judah** and **against** all the **nations**, since the day that I spoke to you, since the days of Josiah, clear down to this day. (**Jeremiah 36:2**)
- Tell it among the **nations** and publish it. And lift up a signal, publish it. Hide nothing, O men. Say, Babylon has been captured. Bel has been put to shame. Merodach has become terrified. Her images have been put to shame. Her dungy idols have become terrified. (**Jeremiah 50:2**)
