Jeremiah 4:2. And if you will certainly swear, As Yehowah is alive in truth, in justice and in righteousness! Then in him¹ the nations will actually bless themselves, and in him they will boast about themselves.

- Yehowah your God you should fear. Him you should serve, and to him you should cling, and by his name you should make sworn statements. (Deuteronomy 10:20)
- So that anyone blessing himself in the earth will bless himself by the God of faith, and anyone making a sworn statement in the earth will swear by the God of faith, because the former distresses will actually be forgotten and because they will actually be concealed from my eyes. (Isaiah 65:16)
- Hear this, O house of Jacob, You who are calling yourselves by the name of Israel and who have come forth from the very waters of Judah, You who are swearing by the name of Yehowah and who make mention even of the God of Israel, not in truth and not in righteousness. (Isaiah 48:1)
- And with the strength of a king, judgment he has loved. You yourself have firmly established uprightness. Judgment and righteousness in Jacob are what you yourself have effected. (Psalms 99:4)
- In Yehowah all the seed of Israel will prove to be right and will boast about themselves. (Isaiah 45:25)
- But let the one bragging about himself brag about himself because of this very thing, the having of insight and the having of knowledge of me, that I am Yehowah, the One exercising loving-kindness, justice and righteousness in the earth, for in these things I do take delight, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 9:24)
- That it may be just as it is written: He that boasts, let him boast in Yehowah. (1 Corinthians 1:31)
- So now swear to me here by God that you will not prove false to me and to my offspring and to my posterity, that, according to

- the loyal love with which I have dealt with you, you will deal with me and with the land in which you have been residing as an alien. (Genesis 21:23)
- At this she said; As Yehowah your God is living, I have no round cake, but a handful of flour in the large jar and a little oil in the small jar, and here I am gathering up a few pieces of wood, and I must go in and make something for myself and my son, and we shall have to eat it and die. (1 Kings 17:12)
- Yehowah himself has sent me clear to Bethel. But Elisha said; As Yehowah is living and as your soul is living, I will not leave you. So they went down to Bethel. (2 Kings 2:2)
- And the king kept standing by the pillar and now concluded the covenant before Yehowah, to walk after Yehowah and to keep his commandments and his testimonies and his statutes with all the heart and with all the soul by carrying out the words of this covenant that were written in this book. Accordingly all the people took their stand in the covenant. (2 Kings 23:3)
- Then Gedaliah swore to them and their men and said to them;
 Do not be afraid of being servants to the Chaldeans. Dwell in the land and serve the king of Babylon, and it will go well with YOU.

 (2 Kings 25:24)
- In that day there will prove to be five cities in the land of Egypt speaking the language of Canaan and swearing to Yehowah of armies. The City of Tearing Down will one city be called. (Isaiah 19:18)
- By my own self I have sworn, out of my own mouth in righteousness the word has gone forth, so that it will not return, that to me every knee will bend down, every tongue will swear. (Isaiah 45:23)
- And it must occur that if they will without fail learn the ways of my people in swearing by my name; As Yehowah is alive! Just as they taught my people to swear by Baal, they will also be built up in the midst of my people. (Jeremiah 12:16)
- And I began to hear the man clothed with the linen, who was up above the waters of the stream, as he proceeded to raise his right hand and his left hand to the heavens and to swear by the One who is alive for time indefinite; It will be for an appointed

- time, appointed times and a half. And as soon as there will have been a finishing of the dashing of the power of the holy people to pieces, all these things will come to their finish. (Daniel 12:7)
- And I will engage you to me for time indefinite, and I will engage you to me in righteousness and in justice and in loving-kindness and in mercies. (Hosea 2:19)
- And I shall certainly bring them in, and they must reside in the midst of Jerusalem, and they must become my people, and I myself shall become their God in trueness and in righteousness. (Zechariah 8:8)
- And calamity to one another do not you scheme up in your hearts, and do not love any false oath, for these are all things that I have hated, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Zechariah 8:17)
