

Jeremiah 4:24• **I saw the mountains, and, look! They were rocking, and the hills themselves were all given a shaking.**

[9] - References:

- That is why the anger of Yehowah has grown hot against his people, and he will stretch out his hand against them and strike them. And the **mountains** will be agitated, and their dead bodies will become like the offal in the midst of the streets. In view of all this his anger has not turned back, but his hand is stretched out still. (**Isaiah 5:25**)
- And because of me the fish of the sea and the flying creatures of the heavens and the wild beasts of the field and all the creeping things that are creeping on the ground and all mankind that are upon the surface of the ground will be bound to shiver, and the **mountains** will actually be thrown down and the steep ways will have to fall, and to the earth even every wall will fall. (**Ezekiel 38:20**)
- Mountains themselves have rocked because of him, and the very **hills** found themselves melting. And the earth will be upheaved because of his face, the productive land also, and all those dwelling in it. (**Nahum 1:5**)
- He stood still, that he might shake up the earth. He saw, and then caused nations to leap. And the eternal **mountains** got to be smashed, the indefinitely lasting **hills** bowed down. The walkings of long ago are his. (**Habakkuk 3:6**)
- And he makes them skip about like a calf, Lebanon and Sirion like the sons of wild bulls. (**Psalms 29:6**)
- The **mountains** themselves skipped about like rams, the **hills** like lambs. (**Psalms 114:4**)
- The land has absolutely burst apart, the land has absolutely been shaken up, the land has absolutely been sent staggering. (**Isaiah 24:19**)
- I shall devastate **mountains** and **hills**, and all their vegetation I shall dry up. And I will turn rivers into islands, and reedy pools I shall dry up. (**Isaiah 42:15**)

- **For this is what Yehowah of armies has said, Yet once, it is a little while, and I am **rocking** the heavens and the earth and the sea and the dry ground. (**Haggai 2:6**)**
