- To fulfill Yehowah's word by the mouth of Jeremiah, until the **land** had paid off its Sabbaths. All the days of lying desolated it kept Sabbath, to fulfill seventy years. (**2 Chronicles 36:21**)
- At this I **said**; How long, O Yehowah? Then he **said**; Until the cities actually crash in ruins, to be without an inhabitant, and the houses be without earthling man, and the ground itself is ruined into a desolation. (**Isaiah 6:11**)
- One **has** made it a **desolate waste**, it **has** withered away, it is desolated to me. The **whole land has** been made **desolate**, because there is no man that **has** taken it to heart. (**Jeremiah 12:11**)
- And I shall actually make the **land** a **desolate waste**, even a desolation, and the pride of its strength must be made to cease and the mountains of Israel must be laid **desolate**, with no one passing through. (**Ezekiel 33:28**)
- And I, for my part, **will** lay the **land desolate**, and **YOUR** enemies who are dwelling in it **will** simply stare in amazement over it. (**Leviticus 26:32**)
- Listen! A report! Here it **has** come, also a great pounding from the **land** of the north, in order to make the cities of Judah a **desolate waste**, the lair of jackals. (**Jeremiah 10:22**)
- One **has** made it a **desolate waste**, it **has** withered away, it is desolated to me. The **whole land has** been made **desolate**, because there is no man that **has** taken it to heart. (**Jeremiah 12:11**)
- And even in those days, is the utterance of **Yehowah**, I shall not **carry out** an **extermination** of **you** men. (**Jeremiah 5:18**)

- And I **will** make Jerusalem piles of stones, the lair of jackals, and the cities of Judah I shall make a **desolate waste**, without an inhabitant. (**Jeremiah 9:11**)
- Neither their silver nor their gold **will** be able to deliver them in the day of Yehowah's fury, but by the fire of his zeal the **whole** earth **will** be devoured, because he **will** make an **extermination**, indeed a terrible one, of all the inhabitants of the earth. (**Zephaniah 1:18**)
