Jeremiah 4:5... Tell it in Judah, you men, and publish it even in Jerusalem, and say it out, and blow a horn¹ throughout the land. Call out loudly² and say; Gather yourselves together, and let us enter into the fortified cities.

- Tell this in the house of Jacob, and publish it in Judah, saying; (Jeremiah 5:20)
- Hear the words of this covenant, YOU men! And you must speak them to the men of Judah and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem. (Jeremiah 11:2)
- Take shelter, O you sons of Benjamin, from the midst of Jerusalem, and in Tekoa blow the horn. And over Bethhaccherem raise a fire signal, because calamity itself has looked down out of the north, even a great crash. (Jeremiah 6:1)
- And he really sees the sword coming upon the land and blows the horn and warns the people. (Ezekiel 33:3)
- To your mouth, a horn! One comes like an eagle against the house of Yehowah, for the reason that they have overstepped my covenant, and against my Law they have transgressed. (Hosea 8:1)
- If a horn is blown in a city, do not also the people themselves tremble? If a calamity occurs in the city, is it not also Yehowah who has acted? (Amos 3:6)
- Why are we sitting still? Gather yourselves together, and let us enter into the fortified cities and be silent there. For Yehowah our God has himself put us to silence, and he gives us poisoned water to drink, because we have sinned against Yehowah. (Jeremiah 8:14)
- But it came about when Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon came up against the land that we began to say; Come, and let us enter into Jerusalem because of the military force of the

- Chaldeans and because of the military force of the Syrians, and let us dwell in Jerusalem. (Jeremiah 35:11)
- And they must blow on them both, and the whole assembly must keep their appointment with you at the entrance of the tent of meeting. (Numbers 10:3)
- When the military forces of the king of Babylon were fighting against Jerusalem and against all the cities of Judah that were left remaining, against Lachish and against Azekah, for they, the fortified cities, were the ones that remained over among the cities of Judah. (Jeremiah 34:7)
- They have blown the trumpet and there has been a preparing of everybody, but there is no one going to the battle, because my hot feeling is against all its crowd. (Ezekiel 7:14)
- BLow a horn in Gibeah, a trumpet in Ramah! Sноит a war cry at Beth-aven, after you, O Benjamin! (Hosea 5:8)
- Blow a horn in Zion, O men, and shout a war cry in my holy mountain. Let all the inhabitants of the land get agitated, for the day of Yehowah is coming, for it is near! (Joel 2:1)
- You yourself will also become drunk, you will become something hidden. You yourself also will seek a stronghold from the enemy. (Nahum 3:11)
