Determine 4:8" On this account gird on sackcloth, you people. Beat your breasts and howl, because the burning anger of Yehowah has not turned back from us.

[13] - References:

- O daughter of my people, gird on sackcloth and wallow in the ashes. Make your mourning that for an only son, the wailing of bitterness, because suddenly the despoiler will come upon us. (Jeremiah 6:26)
- And now also, the utterance of Yehowah is, come back to me with all YOUR hearts, and with fasting and with weeping and with wailing. (Joel 2:12)
- And I will turn YOUR festivals into mourning and all YOUR songs into a dirge, and I will bring up upon all hips sackcloth and upon every head baldness, and I will make the situation like the mourning for an only son, and the end result of it as a bitter day. (Amos 8:10)
- Cry out and howl, O son of man, for it itself has come to be against my people, it is against all the chieftains of Israel. The very ones hurled to the sword have come to be with my people. Therefore make a slap on the thigh. (Ezekiel 21:12)
- That is why Yehowah will not rejoice even over their young men, and upon their fatherless boys and upon their widows he will have no mercy, because all of them are apostates and evildoers and every mouth is speaking senselessness. In view of all this his anger has not turned back, but his hand is stretched out still. (Isaiah 9:17)
- Except it be that one must bow down under the prisoners and that people keep falling under those who have been killed? In view of all this his anger has not turned back, but his hand is stretched out still. (Isaiah 10:4)
- And it must occur that instead of balsam oil there will come to be merely a musty smell, and instead of a belt, a rope, and instead of an artistic hair arrangement, baldness, and instead of a rich garment, a girding of sackcloth, a brand mark instead of prettiness. (Isaiah 3:24)

- Beat yourselves upon the breasts in lamentation over the desirable fields, over the fruit-bearing vine. (Isaiah 32:12)
- Howl, You shepherds, and cry out! And wallow about, You majestic ones of the flock, because Your days for slaughtering and for Your scatterings have been fulfilled, and You must fall like a desirable vessel! (Jeremiah 25:34)
- Howl, O Heshbon, for Ai has been despoiled! Cry out, O dependent towns of Rabbah. Gird sackcloth on yourselves. Wail, and rove about among the stone pens, for Malcam himself will go even into exile, his priests and his princes, all together. (Jeremiah 49:3)
- Wake up, You drunkards, and weep, and howl, all You wine drinkers, on account of sweet wine, for it has been cut off from YOUR mouths. (Joel 1:5)
- Gird yourselves, and beat YOUR breasts, YOU priests. Howl, YOU ministers of the altar. Come in, spend the night in sackcloth, YOU ministers of my God, for from the house of YOUR God grain offering and drink offering have been withheld. (Joel 1:13)
- Howl, You inhabitants of Maktesh, for all the people who are tradesmen have been silenced, all those weighing out silver have been cut off. (Zephaniah 1:11)
