

Jeremiah 4:8 On this account gird on sackcloth, **you** people. Beat **your** breasts and howl, because the burning anger of Yehowah has not turned back from us.

[13] - References:

- O daughter of my **people**, gird on **sackcloth** and wallow in the ashes. Make your mourning that for an only son, the wailing of bitterness, because suddenly the despoiler will come upon us. (**Jeremiah 6:26**)
- And now also, the utterance of **Yehowah** is, come **back** to me with all **your** hearts, and with fasting and with weeping and with wailing. (**Joel 2:12**)
- And I will turn **your** festivals into mourning and all **your** songs into a dirge, and I will bring up upon all hips **sackcloth** and upon every head baldness, and I will make the situation like the mourning for an only son, and the end result of it as a bitter day. (**Amos 8:10**)
- Cry out and **howl**, O son of man, for it itself **has** come to be against my **people**, it is against all the chieftains of Israel. The very ones hurled to the sword have come to be with my **people**. Therefore make a slap on the thigh. (**Ezekiel 21:12**)
- That is why **Yehowah** will not rejoice even over their young men, and upon their fatherless boys and upon their widows he will have no mercy, because all of them are apostates and evildoers and every mouth is speaking senselessness. In view of all this his **anger has** not **turned back**, but his hand is stretched out still. (**Isaiah 9:17**)
- Except it be that one must bow down under the prisoners and that **people** keep falling under those who have been killed? In view of all this his **anger has** not **turned back**, but his hand is stretched out still. (**Isaiah 10:4**)
- And it must occur that instead of balsam oil there will come to be merely a musty smell, and instead of a belt, a rope, and instead of an artistic hair arrangement, baldness, and instead of a rich garment, a girding of **sackcloth**, a brand mark instead of prettiness. (**Isaiah 3:24**)

- **Beat** yourselves upon the **breasts** in lamentation over the desirable fields, over the fruit-bearing vine. (**Isaiah 32:12**)
- **Howl, YOU** shepherds, and cry out! And wallow about, **YOU** majestic ones of the flock, because **YOUR** days for slaughtering and for **YOUR** scatterings have been fulfilled, and **YOU** must fall like a desirable vessel! (**Jeremiah 25:34**)
- **Howl, O Heshbon, for Ai has** been despoiled! Cry out, O dependent towns of Rabbah. Gird **sackcloth** on yourselves. Wail, and rove about among the stone pens, for Malcam himself will go even into exile, his priests and his princes, all together. (**Jeremiah 49:3**)
- Wake up, **YOU** drunkards, and weep, and **howl**, all **YOU** wine drinkers, on account of sweet wine, for it **has** been cut off from **YOUR** mouths. (**Joel 1:5**)
- Gird yourselves, and beat **YOUR breasts, YOU** priests. **Howl, YOU** ministers of the altar. Come in, spend the night in **sackcloth, you** ministers of my God, for from the house of **YOUR** God grain offering and drink offering have been withheld. (**Joel 1:13**)
- **Howl, YOU** inhabitants of Maktesh, for all the **people** who are tradesmen have been silenced, all those weighing out silver have been cut off. (**Zephaniah 1:11**)
