- The pronouncement against **Babylon** that Isaiah the son of Amoz saw in vision! (**Isaiah 13:1**)
- Then he went out from the **land** of the **Chaldeans** and took up residence in Haran. And from there, after his father died, God caused him to change his residence to this **land** in which **you** now dwell. (**Acts of Apostles 7:4**)
- That is why its name was called Babel, because there **Yehowah** had confused the language of all the earth, and **Yehowah** had scattered them from there over all the surface of the earth. (**Genesis 11:9**)
- Against the **land** of Merathaim, come up against her and against the inhabitants of Pekod. Let there be a massacre and a devoting to destruction close upon them, is the utterance of **Yehowah**, and do according to all that I have commanded you. (**Jeremiah 50:21**)
- There is a sword against the Chaldeans, is the utterance of **Yehowah**, and against the inhabitants of **Babylon** and against her princes and against her wise ones. (**Jeremiah 50:35**)
- This is the interpretation of the word; **MENE**, God has numbered the days of your kingdom and has finished it. (**Daniel 5:26**)
