- In those **days** and at that time I shall make sprout for David a righteous sprout, and he **will** certainly execute justice and righteousness in the land. (**Jeremiah 33:15**)
- I **will** wipe out your transgressions just as with a cloud, and your **sins** just as with a cloud mass. Do return to me, for I **will** repurchase you. (**Isaiah 44:22**)
- And they **will** no more teach each one his companion and each one his brother, saying; **Know** Yehowah! For they **will** all of them know me, from the least one of them even to the greatest one of them, is the **utterance** of **Yehowah**. For I shall **forgive** their **error**, and their sin I shall remember no more. (**Jeremiah 31:34**)
- Unless **Yehowah** of armies himself had left remaining to us just a few survivors, we should have become just like Sodom, we should have resembled Gomorrah itself. (**Isaiah 1:9**)
- He **will** again show us mercy, he **will** subject our **errors**. And you **will** throw into the depths of the sea all their **sins**. (**Micah 7:19**)
- You have pardoned the **error** of your people, you have covered all their sin. (**Psalms 85:2**)
- He **will** not for all time keep finding fault, neither **will** he to time indefinite keep resentful. (**Psalms 103:9**)
- And no resident **will** say; I am sick. The people that are dwelling in the land **will** be those pardoned for their **error**. (**Isaiah 33:24**)
- I, I am the One that is wiping out your transgressions for my own sake, and your **sins** I shall not remember. (**Isaiah 43:25**)
- Your **error**, O daughter of Zion, has come to its finish. He **will** not carry you off into exile again. He has turned his attention to your **error**, O daughter of Edom. He has uncovered your **sins**. (**Lamentations 4:22**)

- **Who is a God like you, one pardoning **error** and passing over transgression of the remnant of his inheritance? He **will** certainly not hold onto his anger forever, for he is delighting in loving-kindness. (**Micah 7:18**)**
