- Suddenly **Babylon** has fallen, so that she is broken. Howl over her, **you** people. Take balsam for her pain. Perhaps she may be healed. (**Jeremiah 51:8**)
- One runner runs to meet another runner, and one reporter to meet another reporter, to report to the king of **Babylon** that his city has been captured at every end. (**Jeremiah 51:31**)
- In that very night Belshazzar the Chaldean king was killed. (**Daniel 5:30**)
- That is why in one day her plagues will come, death and mourning and famine, and she will be completely burned with fire, because **Yehowah** God, who judged her, is strong. (**Revelation 18:8**)
- He is wise in heart and strong in power. Who can show stubbornness to him and come off uninjured? (**Job 9:4**)
- Or, are we inciting **Yehowah** to jealousy? We are not stronger than he is, are we? (**1 Corinthians 10:22**)
- Tell it among the nations and publish it. And lift up a signal, publish it. Hide nothing, O men. Say, Babylon has been captured. Bel has been put to shame. Merodach has become terrified. Her images **have** been put to shame. Her dungy idols **have** become terrified. (**Jeremiah 50:2**)
