

Jeremiah 50:42 **· Bow and javelin they handle. They are cruel and will show no mercy. The sound of them is like the sea that is boisterous, and upon horses they will ride, set in array as one man for war against you, O daughter of Babylon.**

[12] - References:

- For here I am arousing and bringing up **against Babylon** a congregation of great nations from the land of the north, and they **will** certainly **array** themselves **against** her. From there she **will** be captured. One's arrows are like those of a mighty **man** causing bereavement of children, who does not come back without results. (**Jeremiah 50:9**)
- O **daughter of Babylon**, who are to be despoiled, happy **will** he be that rewards you with your own treatment with which you treated us. (**Psalms 137:8**)
- And their bows **will** dash even young men to pieces. And the fruitage of the belly they **will** not pity, for sons their eye **will** not feel sorry. (**Isaiah 13:18**)
- And the ten horns that you saw, and the wild beast, these **will** hate the harlot and **will** make her devastated and naked, and **will** eat up her fleshy parts and **will** completely burn her with fire. (**Revelation 17:16**)
- And they **will** growl over it in that day as with the growling of the **sea**. And one **will** actually gaze at the land, and, look! There is distressing darkness, and even the light has grown dark because of the drops falling on it. (**Isaiah 5:30**)
- The **sea** has come up even over **Babylon**. By the multitude of its waves she has been covered. (**Jeremiah 51:42**)
- At the **sound** of the stamping of the hoofs of his stallions, at the rattling of his **war** chariots, the turmoil of his wheels, the fathers **will** actually not turn around to the sons, because of the dropping down of their hands. (**Jeremiah 47:3**)
- Lift up a signal in the land, O men. Blow a horn among the nations. Sanctify **against** her the nations. Summon **against** her the kingdoms of Ararat, Minni and Ashkenaz. Commission **against** her a recruiting officer. Make the **horses** come up like bristly locusts. (**Jeremiah 51:27**)

- **Look! The day of Yehowah itself is coming, **cruel** both with fury and with burning anger, in order to make the land an object of astonishment, and that it may annihilate the land's sinners out of it. (Isaiah 13:9)**
- **Come down and sit down in the dust, O virgin **daughter** of **Babylon**. Sit down on the earth where there is no throne, O **daughter** of the Chaldeans. For you **will** not experience again that people call you delicate and dainty. (Isaiah 47:1)**
- **The bow and the **javelin** they **will** grab hold of. It is a **cruel** one, and they **will** have no pity. Their very voice **will** resound just like the **sea**, and upon **horses** they **will ride**. It is drawn up in battle order like a **man** of **war against** you, O **daughter** of Zion. (Jeremiah 6:23)**
- **When they would go, to their four sides they would go. They would not change direction when they went, because the place to which the head would face, after it they would go. They would not change direction when they went. (Ezekiel 10:11)**
