[6] - References:

- Here there is the sound of the cry for help of the daughter of my people from a land far away; Is Yehowah not in Zion? Or is her king not in her? Why is it that they have offended me with their graven images, with their vain foreign gods? (**Jeremiah 8:19**)
- Do there exist among the vain idols of the nations any that can pour down rain, or can even the heavens themselves give copious showers? Are you not the One, O Yehowah our God? And we hope in you, for you yourself have done all these things. (**Jeremiah 14:22**)
- Look! All of them are something nonexistent. Their **works** are nothing. Their molten images are wind and unreality. (**Isaiah 41:29**)
- They are vanity, a **work** of **mockery**. In the time of their **being given attention** they **will perish**. (**Jeremiah 10:15**)
- This is what **you** men **will** say to them; The gods that did not make the very heavens and the earth are the ones who **will perish** from the earth and from under these heavens. (**Jeremiah 10:11**)
