- Upon a mountain of bare rocks raise up a **signal**, **you men**. Lift up the voice to them, wave the hand, that they may **come** into the entrances of the nobles. (**Isaiah 13:2**)

- Come in to her from the farthest part. Open up her granaries. Bank her up, just like those making heaps, and devote her to destruction. May she not **come** to have any remaining ones. (**Jeremiah 50:26**)
