- Now as regards Ahimaaz the son of Zadok, he said; Let me run, please, and break the news to the **king**, because Yehowah **has** judged him to free him from the hand of his enemies. (**2 Samuel 18:19**)
- The couriers themselves, riding post horses used in the royal service, went forth, being urged forward and being moved with speed by the king's word, and the Law itself was given out in Shushan the castle. (**Esther 8:14**)
- And upon you calamity must come, you will know no charming against it. And upon you adversity will fall, you will not be able to avert it. And upon you there will suddenly come a ruin that you are not accustomed to know. (**Isaiah 47:11**)
- I have laid a snare for you and you have also been caught, O **Babylon**, and you yourself did not know it. You were found and also taken hold of, for it was against Yehowah that you excited yourself. (**Jeremiah 50:24**)
- The **king** of **Babylon has** heard the **report** about them, and his hands have dropped down. There is distress! Severe pains have seized hold of him, just like a woman giving birth. (**Jeremiah 50:43**)
- And there was a sending of the letters by means of couriers to all the king's jurisdictional districts, to annihilate, to kill and to destroy all the Jews, young man as well as old man, little ones and women, on one day, on the thirteenth day of the twelfth month, that is, the month Adar, and to plunder the spoil of them. (**Esther 3:13**)
- In that very night Belshazzar the Chaldean **king** was killed. (**Daniel 5:30**)
