

Jeremiah 51:33 For this is what Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, has said; The daughter of Babylon is like a threshing floor. It is the time to tread her down solid. Yet a little while and the time of the harvest must come for her.

- O my threshed ones and the son of my **threshing floor**, what I have heard from **Yehowah** of **armies**, the **God of Israel**, I have reported to **you** people. (**Isaiah 21:10**)
- Look! I have made you a **threshing** sledge, a new **threshing** instrument having double-edged teeth. You will **tread down** the mountains and crush them, and the hills you will make just like the chaff. (**Isaiah 41:15**)
- This is what **Yehowah has said**; On account of three revolts of Damascus, and on account of four, I shall not turn it back, on account of their **threshing** Gilead even with iron **threshing** instruments. (**Amos 1:3**)
- Get up and thresh, O **daughter** of Zion, for your horn I shall change into iron, and your hoofs I shall change into copper, and you will certainly pulverize many peoples, and by a ban you will actually devote to **Yehowah** their unjust profit, and their resources to the true Lord of the whole earth. (**Micah 4:13**)
- With denunciation you went marching through the earth. In anger you went **threshing** the nations. (**Habakkuk 3:12**)
- Let both grow together until the **harvest**, and in the **harvest** season I will tell the reapers, First collect the weeds and bind them in bundles to burn them up, then go to gathering the wheat into my storehouse. (**Matthew 13:30**)
- And another angel emerged from the temple sanctuary, crying with a loud voice to the one seated on the cloud; Put your sickle in and reap, because the hour **has come** to reap, for the **harvest** of the earth is thoroughly ripe. (**Revelation 14:15**)
- And jackals **must** howl in her dwelling towers, and the big snake will be in the palaces of exquisite delight. And the season for her is near to **come**, and her days themselves will not be postponed. (**Isaiah 13:22**)

- Come **down** and sit **down** in the dust, O virgin **daughter** of **Babylon**. Sit **down** on the earth where there is no throne, O **daughter** of the Chaldeans. For you will not experience again that people call you delicate and dainty. (**Isaiah 47:1**)
- **THRUST** in a sickle, for **harvest has** grown ripe. Come, descend, for the winepress **has** become full. The press vats actually overflow, for their badness **has** become abundant. (**Joel 3:13**)
