- I well know that Yehowah will execute the legal claim of the afflicted one, the judgment of the poor ones. (**Psalms 140:12**)
- Their Repurchaser is strong, Yehowah of armies being his name. Without fail he will conduct their legal case, in order that he may actually give repose to the land and cause agitation to the inhabitants of Babylon. (**Jeremiah 50:34**)
- Vengeance is mine, and retribution. At the appointed time their foot will move unsteadily, for the day of their disaster is near, and the events in readiness for them do make haste. (**Deuteronomy 32:35**)
- Yehowah has broken the rod of the wicked ones, the staff of the ruling ones. (**Isaiah 14:5**)
